Dear Ms. Kimmel:

Fox Television Stations, Inc., the licensee of WTTG, Washington, DC ("WTTG"), hereby responds to the Notice of Informal Complaint, as identified above, dated March 28, 2011¹ ("NOIC"). An email acknowledging the receipt of the NOIC was sent to Ms. Proulx on April 1, 2011, and is attached as Exhibit A.

After receiving the NOIC, WTTG reviewed its over-the-air recordings of *Change of Plans* as broadcast on January 8, 2011, beginning at 8:00 p.m. Ms. Proulx states in her Disability Access Complaint that captioning was missing from about half of the movie, and was otherwise not operative. The over-the-air recording, however, shows the closed captions were present and functioning properly.

Since the recording of the over-the-air signal showed that the closed captioning as broadcast was working properly, the closed captioning issues must have their genesis elsewhere. Unfortunately, WTTG is not able to offer any further guidance because the closed captioning was functioning properly as broadcast by WTTG.
