## Issues Program List

**Quarterly Issues Programs List for July 1, 2019 – September 30, 2019**  
**The stations have identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:**

- A. Veteran Affairs.** The Quad Cities is home to a military base and a large number of military veterans. The stations supported the 1<sup>st</sup> ever Quad Cities Veterans Action Center. The summit brought together veterans with organizations providing assistance to vets that included VBA help, PTSD services, Honor Flight, medical care and more.
- B. Cancer.** Cancer effects everyone and the stations were involved in a fundraiser to support pediatric cancer. The program was called “Cones against Cancer” and during the month of September a portion of proceeds for ice cream cones bought at a local store went to local organizations involved in cancer research. The hosts talked about the fundraiser, how listeners can help, and how it affected them personally.
- C. Spinal Muscular Atrophy.** SMA is a disease that takes away the ability to walk, eat and even breathe. The stations supported “Tribute Fest”, a free concert that took donations to help families dealing with SMA, and to continue to raise awareness of the disease and provide funds for research. SMA is the number one genetic cause of death for infants. Currently there is no cure.
- D. Musical Education.** Music education is something many schools around the Quad Cities are cutting due to lack of budgets. Especially in lower income schools. We helped bring awareness of the need for musical education and the need for instruments. Plus we helped raise money for the instruments and lessons for children that cannot afford it.
- E. Human Trafficking.** Human trafficking and forced labor is a worldwide issue. Here in the Quad Cities we experience this as well. We are based along the I-80 corridor connecting the western states to Chicago which is used for trafficking narcotics and people. We need to keep people aware of the warning signs and what to do if suspected human trafficking is occurring.
- F. College Financial Aid.** As listeners send their children back to school, they begin to deal with tuition for after public school ends. Keeping the public informed of the importance of not only doing research on what good financial aid is available to them, but also what to avoid.
