KCTV had four reporters with live reports before, during and following the funeral proceedings from the Vineyard Church to White Chapel Memorial Gardens Cemetery, where Vasquez was buried.

Election SpecialSeptember 25, 20224:00pm-5:00pmKCTV aired its first election special anchored by Brad Stephens and Carolyn Long. Former Kansas City
mayor Sly James appeared on the show as a political analyst along with Pete Mundo. Reports from a
national reporter and a package from KCTV reporter Betsy Webster touched on the potential swing of
the balance of power depending on the results of the election and how Kansas' role in the abortion
topic plays a role nationally on the issue. The show also touched on Missouri voter's pending decision
on recreational marijuana.
