1st Quarter Special Programming Notes

KCTV made changes to or extended its normal programming for special and/or breaking news events. Or, provided in-depth coverage of special and/or breaking news events.

Those events for the first quarter of 2022 were:

Kingdom Comeback January 27, 2022 6:30pm – 7:00pm
KCTV broadcast a live 30 minute special previewing the Kansas City Chiefs upcoming AFC Championship game. The special was hosted by sports anchor Dani Welniak and former Kansas City Chiefs player Dezman Moses. They looked back at the Chiefs surprising comeback win last week, and previewed Sunday's game. Reporter Neal Jones also looked back at all the Chiefs greatest comeback wins, and why last weeks win over the Buffalo Bills was the talk of the town.

Snowstorm Coverage February 2, 2022 7:00am – 10:00am
KCTV extended its morning news programming from 7:00am until 10:00am to provide in-depth coverage of heavy snow falling and forecasted for the Kansas City metro area. Several KCTV reporters provided live reports, including traffic conditions, from Lee's Summit and Grain Valley in Missouri, and Overland Park, Kansas. Coverage also included live phone interviews with city and transportation officials from Kansas City, MO., Olathe, Kansas, and Kansas City International Airport.

Olathe East High School Shooting March 4, 2022 11:15am – 3:00pm
KCTV interrupted its regular programming to provide live breaking news coverage of a triple shooting inside a high school in Olathe, Kansas. Several KCTV reporters provided live reports from outside Olathe East High School, and Olathe Medical Center. Our reporters provided live interviews with police, school officials, students, and parents. KCTV provided a live look as students were reunited with their families.

Kansas redistricting veto	February 3, 2022	10pm	:28
KCTV reports Kansas Governor Laura Kelly has vetoed an effort to re-draw the state's congressional districts. The map passed by Republican majorities in the Kansas House and Senate splits Wyandotte County into two districts, and moves the city of Lawrence into another district. Republicans may have the votes to override the veto.
