Each quarter of the year we place in our public inspection file a list of what we (WRDR Freehold, NJ) have seen as the problems and/or needs of our service area (New Jersey) in the preceding three months. Following you will find a list of the programs we aired that addressed those specific concerns.

The following is our list of issues and concerns for the Monmouth and Ocean counties area quarter ending **December 31, 2022**. Following this list are specific WRDR programs that aired in response to these issues. This report is arranged by identifying the category on the issues list, the programs that aired which gave significant treatment to that issue, along with its topic, discussion, date and time aired. Concluding each category will be the documentation of every public service announcement that aired in response/support to the issue of that particular category.

1. Parenting - In this day and age, traditional families are rare. Today there is a battle raging about what is right for the family. A case can be made for the need of traditional family values, such as having two parents, maintaining discipline, teaching respect for adults, and moms staying home with their kids. These are some things that will be addressed this quarter on The Bridge.
2. Money - Our culture is focused on money, which often is their idol. This issue is addressed by programming on The Bridge.
