WRDR ISSUES AND PROGRAM LIST QUARTER ENDING – March 31, 2023

Each quarter of the year we place in our public inspection file a list of what we (WRDR Freehold, NJ) have seen as the problems and/or needs of our service area (New Jersey) in the preceding three months. Concluding each category will be the documentation of every public service announcement that aired in response/support to the issue of that particular category.

- 1. Parenting In this day and age, traditional families and rare. Today there is a battle raging about what is right for the family. A case can be made for the need of traditional family values, such as having two parents, maintaining discipline, teaching respect for adults, and moms staying home with their kids. These are some things that will be addressed this quarter on The Bridge.
- 2. <u>Marriage</u> We at The Bridge want to help people understand the proper marriage relationship. Many of our teachers address marriage issues and related solutions.
- 3. <u>Immorality</u> Our increasingly immoral society impacts the individual, the family, the community, and beyond. This issue is addressed by programming on The Bridge.

- 6. Trials The Bible is clear that life will include many trials. The Bridge airs programming on this topic.

The pastors discuss marriage. The Bible has many instances of polygamy. A caller asks about God's acceptance (or not) of this. Polygamy is not God's original choice. God allowed a number of things in that early culture. Those wives may have been destitute and no others would have them. But in some cases the polygamous relationships turned out to be problematic and took people farther from God.

Pastor Lloyd Pulley discusses marriage. How do you convince your wife that she's number 1 in your life? It's the way you live it. This will speak for how you prioritize your wife and marriage. Pastor warns, do not ever marry an angry person. Something is very wrong about someone not being able to control their own anger.

Dr. Dobson discusses immorality, and churches that are increasingly accepting the gay agenda in their doctrine. This is tragic and acts against the Spirit's work to heal and convince gays to live a biblical lifestyle. Guest Ann was formerly living a gay lifestyle. But she is now walking with Jesus after God just entered her life with a clear message from Him.

The Voice of Truth March 25 4:30 pm Sat

Pastor Johnny Zacchio tells the biblical story of a half brother Amnon forcing himself on his half sister Tamar against her will. Afterwards Amnon was done with her, and hated her as much as he previously wanted her. Pastor Johnny emphasizes, in all circumstances within marriage or outside of it, No means NO. The Bible warns us to choose our friends wisely. Also, family members could be immoral and not walking with the Lord. Parents need to protect your children from bad influences.

A caller asked where marijuana came from, the fall of man, and are plants to be cursed? Pastor Lloyd discussed the addictive and destructive nature of this and other drugs. In his personal experience, he forgot and lost 5 years of life while using marijuana. God doesn't want us indulging on drugs that affect and injure the brain.

Pastors Lloyd Pulley and rob Baltodano discuss death with a caller who lost a good friend. He asks, will he know him and his family in Heaven? Pastor Lloyd's son had passed, and these questions arose for him also. God's plan is most important. Our grief will end when we get to Heaven.

Pastor Jerel Hagerman discusses death. He said watching a saved vs. unsaved person as they decline and pass in the hospital is a completely different thing. Mourning is harder for the relative of an unsaved person. Pastor Jerel tells the story of an unsaved man who died in terror, and a saved man who died in peace and smiling. Fearing death isn't necessary for those who are saved.

A caller said his father was paraplegic. He was not right with God, although he taught his son about love in how he treated him. The pastors said unless he was right with God's requirements for Heaven, he's not saved based on his health trials.
