Interviews and Public Service Announcements which ran in the fourth quarter of 2022:

The Following Interviews took place in the public interest

Tony Lombardi, a representative of the Outer Banks Anglers Club discussed the organization and the need for new members to come to the meetings, and when they were going to have their next meeting. The group meets in Southern Shores at the Pitts Center on the last Monday of each month

The following Public Service Announcement campaigns ran. Each was at least 30 seconds long and scheduled 5 times per day.

Corolla Wild Horse Fund. These started 4/16 and will continue through 1/15/2023. Corolla Wild Horse Fund is a nonprofit that raises awareness and cares for the wild horse population on the Outer Banks.: Don't Feed the Ponies. These PSA's advise the public on the dangers of feeding the Corolla Wild Ponies foods that domesticated animals would normally eat. The Ponies have adapted to a diet of wild marsh grasses, and snacks like carrots, apples, or oats can kill them.

12/2-12/9/2022- Southern Hope Animal Rescue- Christmas in the Country. This is a Fundraiser for Southern Hope Animal rescue, an all species animal rescue, helping slaughter bound equines rehabilitate and find forever homes, and assisting local shelters and animal control with the placement of farm animals and companion animals of all kinds as well as accepting owner surrendered animals.

10/31-11/4- Center for Dolphin Research Shrimp Crawl. The Outer Banks Center for Dolphin Research is a non-profit organization dedicated to promote the conservation of bottlenose dolphins on the Outer Banks. This is a primary fundraiser for the organization involving a variety of restaurant locations. Tickets purchased allow people access to several restaurants to sample shrimp dishes while supporting and learning about dolphin research.
