This Quarterly Programs and Issues list reflects the station's most significant programming treatment of community issues.

One way the station addresses local issues was with a program called 'Art and Company'. It aired on Sunday mornings from 7-8AM with an average run time of 45 minutes.

We have live, local, community oriented programming weekdays from 6a-2p and have recently removed the art and company show as of November of 2017. Multiple hours a day are dedicated to public and community outreach and services. Interview segments during this time vary from 12 minutes to 1 hour. We also air a minimum of 30 minutes a week of PSA's from the RIBA and other organizations.
