McKee helped parents understand the value of connection with their kids, concerns about the apps on the phones and shared some tips on how to discuss it with them. He also touched on the dangers of social media and how it is affecting them mentally, physically, and spiritually.

He noted that this is a process and requires both time and energy to leave and accountability to stay away from it once they’ve found the way out of it.

She shared how God has used her anxiety to shape a foundation of trust and beauty as she found herself leaning more and more into God's journey through life for her. She let listeners know that while she is like this, her sister is not, and that anxiety affects people in a variety of ways, and you have to find what works best for you to find the peace and quiet that you are searching for while battling anxiety.

She noted that as a teen she began a destructive cycle of drugs, drinking and promiscuity — and that led to three abortions in her life. Yet thought it all, God intervened, and today she’s a pro-life advocate and leads a ministry of rescuing preborn babies.
