07/05/23. Lake Michigan Carferry says its' S.S. Badger will resume overnight passenger and car ferry services between Ludington, MI and Manitowoc, WI.

07/12/23. Former President Trump is unlikely to participate in at least the first two Republican presidential primary debates according to longtime advisor Jason Miller.

07/19/23. Grand Rapids- The only Dairy Queen in Grand Rapids will remain open with a new fourth-generation owner taking over next year.

07/26/23. Lansing- Michigan motorists have purchased millions of recreation passports since 2011, boosting the Department of Natural Resource's budget by millions annually.

08/02/23. Northern Michigan- Northwest Michigan Habitat for Humanity has delivered a modular home to Alanson. The house was built in Bay City.

08/09/23. Flint- Creative Hair School of Cosmetology in Flint Township gave students free haircuts and school supplies including 100 backpacks.
