The Zion Chapel of Ease Cemetery on Hilton Head Island includes the oldest extant structure on the Island: the Baynard Mausoleum, which was built in 1846 and has fallen into disrepair. Originally the site of an Episcopal Church edified around 1786, the cemetery is a resting place for many revolutionary patriots and their families, along with other citizens of the time, up to the civil war. The Heritage Library now owns and maintains the cemetery and they are working with the Savannah College of Art and Design's Historic Preservation Department to survey the cemetery and the mausoleum to determine what needs to be done to preserve it.
