Real Life 101

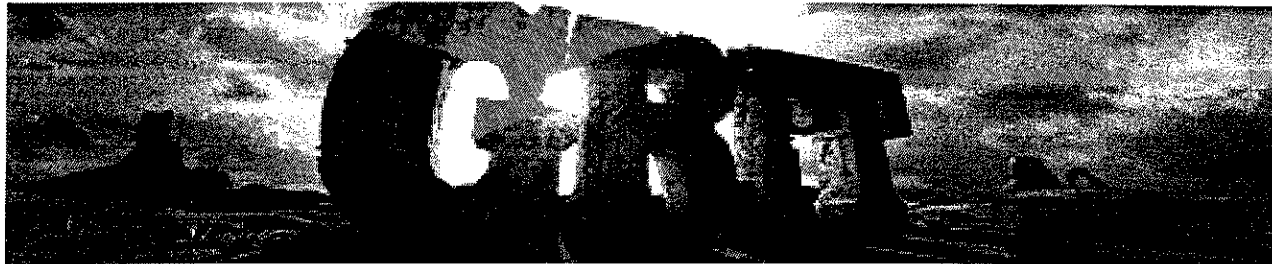
