3	Internship Program	<p>WRNN-TV's internships are structured to teach young adults the skills needed to help obtain a position in the broadcast industry. Participants in WRNN internships are community members or college students who receive college credit for their time spent at the station. WRNN accepts interns in all departments, but mostly in News and Operations Departments. These internships are held throughout the year, accommodating both local college students from local regions and also out-of-state colleges.</p> <p>In 2019, WRNN's HR Department facilitated internship sessions in the Spring (2) and Summer (7).
