THE TRI-COUNTY VETERANS SUPPORT NETWORK...HELPING VETS THRIVE

AIR DATE: APRIL 3, 2022

<u>GUEST:</u> TIM TAYLOR...CO-FOUNDER OF THE TRI-COUNTY VETERANS SUPPORT NETWORK

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE WORK OF THE TRI-COUNTY VETERANS SUPPORT NETWORK. TAYLOR STARTED THE ORGANIZATION WHEN HE BUSINESS STARTED TO FALTER. THE EXPERIENCE LED HIM TO FIND HELP WITH OTHER VETS. IT WAS THEN THAT HE REALIZED NOT ALL VETERANS WERE DOING AS WELL AS HE WAS.

THE ORGANIZATION WORKS TO HELP VETERANS WHO HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO MAKE A SUCCESSFUL TRANSITION FROM MILITARY SERVICE TO THE CIVILIAN WORLD. TAYLOR SAYS IT'S A BIGGER TRANSITION THAN MAN BELIEVE. THE TWO WORLDS ARE VERY DIFFERENT.

HIS ORGANIZATION FINDS MANY VETERANS CAN'T MAKE THE SUCCESSFUL TRANSITION...DUE TO PTSD AND OTHER MENTAL HEALTH PROBLEMS. MANY HAVE A DIFFICULT TIME FINDING WORK. TAYLOR SAYS SOME VETS GO THRU UP TO 20 DIFFERENT JOBS AS THEY WORK TO FIND THEIR PLACE IN THE CIVILIAN WORLD. HE SAYS HE CAN KNOCK A MAN OR WOMAN VET TO THEIR KNEES.

HOUSING IS A PROBLEM FOR SOME VETERANS...AND THOSE WITH HOMES MAY HAVE A HARD TIME STAYING IN THEM DUE TO EXPENSES AND THE NEED FOR HOMES TO BE REPAIRED.

THE ORGANIZATION WORKS THRU OUT THE YEAR TO MAKE VETERANS LIVES BETTER. THE TRI-COUNTY VETERANS SUPPORT NETWORK SAYS IT IS ALWAYS LOOKING FOR MATERIALS FOR HOME REPAIRS.

AND THRU OUT THE YEAR...THE ORGANIZATION HOLDS EVENTS TO RAISE MUCH NEEDED FUNDS TO HELP VETS THRU OUT THE LOW COUNTRY THRU HOLIDAY AND OTHER EVENTS.

## MEN OF CHARLESTON TEACH...CCSD'S EFFORT TO GET MORE MEN OF COLOR INTERESTED IN TEACHING

AIRDATE: APRIL 10, 2022

GUEST: APRIL BUTLER...CHARLESTON COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT HUMAN RESOURCES OFFICER AND DIRECTOR OF THE PATHWAYS TO TEACHING PROJECT

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON A NEW EFFORT (SINCE JANUARY) THAT NOT ONLY IS WORKING TO ATTRACT MORE TEACHERS TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT...BUT TO ATTRACT MORE MEN OF COLOR. THESE APPLICANTS ARE WANTED FOR ALL GRADES...BUT MOSTLY FOR THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS.

DUE TO MORE BLACK AND BROWN STUDENTS IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT...AND MOST COMING FROM SINGLE PARENT HOMES...ITS BELIEVED THAT MALE TEACHERS OF COLOR CAN MAKE A POSITIVE IMPACT ON THESE YOUNG STUDENTS. OFFICIALS SAY THESE YOUNG STUDENTS...BOTH MALE AND FEMALE STUDENTS...NEED STRONG AND POSITIVE MALE INFLUENCES IN THEIR LIVES. AND THE MOVE IS ALSO SEEN AS BEING A POSITIVE INFLUENCE ON MINORITY STUDENTS ALL THE WAY THRU TO THEIR SENIOR YEAR OF HIGH SCHOOL.

THIS PROGRAM IS SAID TO BE THE FIRST OF ITS KIND IN SOUTH CAROLINA...AND ONE OF A VERY FEW IN THE COUNTRY.

THIS PROGRAM DOES NOT REQUIRE YOU COME INTO IT AS A PROFESSIONAL TEACHER. THIS PROGRAM IS FOR GOOD MEN...ESTABLISHED IN RESPONSIBLE POSITIONS...AND WHO

ALREADY HOLD A COLLEGE DEGREE. THEY MUST HAVE GRADUATED WITH A GPA OF 2.75 AT THE MINIMUM.

THE SCHOOL DISTRICT WILL THEN MENTOR THESE MEN AND BRING THEM INTO THE CLASSROOM TO NOT ONLY TEACH...BUT BE POSITIVE ROLE MODELS FOR YOUNG STUDENTS.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN UNIVERSITY'S FAITH AND MENTAL HEALTH CONFERENCE

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN UNIVERSITY HOLDS ITS FAITH AND MENTAL HEALTH CONFERENCE MAY 12-14<sup>TH</sup> AT THE DEWEY CENTER FOR CHAPLAINCY.

THE CONFERENCE WILL EXPLORE THE CONNECTION BETWEEN FAITH AND MENTAL HEALTH. THERE HAVE BEEN COUNTLESS SURVEYS THAT FIND THAT FAITH HAS A CONNECTION TO OUR MENTAL HEALTH. IT PROVIDES A SECURE SENSE OF COMMUNITY AND THAT COMMUNITY CAN HELP INDIVIDUALS THROUGH CHALLENGES.

IN THE AFTERMATH OF THE COVID-19 LOCKDOWNS...THERE'S BEEN A SURGE IN MENTAL HEALTH PROBLEMS...LARGE AND SMALL...TO PEOPLE OF ALL AGES. SURVEYS HAVE FOUND ELEMENTARY SCHOOL KIDS HAVE SUFFERED THE MOST. LOCKDOWNS KEPT THEM FROM FRIENDS AND ACTIVITIES AT SCHOOL.

FOR ADULTS...THOSE ALREADY DEALING WITH PAST TRAUMAS HAVE FELT AN INTENSITY OF FEELING THAT HAVE MAGNIFIED PAST INCIDENTS.

HUMANS ARE SOCIAL CREATURES...AND THE PANDEMIC HAS AFFECTED THE MENTAL HEALTH OF MANY ACCORDING TO SEVERAL STUDIES. MANY HAVE HAD TO WORK ON FEELINGS OF DEPRESSION

DESPITE THE END OF COVID RESTRICTIONS. SOME REMAIN AFFECTED. FAITH (AMONG THE FAITH-BASED) IS SEEN AS THE WAY TO BOUNCE BACK BETTER FROM SETBACKS...SUCH AS THE WANING PANDEMIC.

THE CHALLENGE IN ALL OF THIS IS THAT THE CHURCH HAS BEEN LOSING MEMBERS ACROSS THE BOARD. EFFORTS ARE UNDERWAY TO REMIND THOSE SUFFERING IN SILENCE TO CONSIDER COMING BACK TO RELIGION FOR HEALING.

THE INSPIRATION FOR THIS EFFORT...HER MIDDLE SON FRANKIE. HE'S 24 YEARS OLD AND HE'S GRADUATED FROM CLEMSON THRU A SPECIAL PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS WITH DOWN SYNDROME. HE ALSO PLAYS SPORTS....INCLUDING BASKETBALL, GOLF, FOOTBALL AND MORE.

ANTONELLI ADMITS SHE HAS A HIGH PROFILE PLATFORM TO PROMOTE AND RAISE MONEY FOR SPECIAL OLYMPICS...BUT SHE SAYS ANYONE CAN GET INVOLVED BY SUPPORTING SPECIAL OLYMPICS. THE NUMBER OF SPECIAL OLYMPICS ATHLETES IN SOUTH CAROLINA STANDS AROUND 30-THOUSAND...AND GROWING.

HER 24-HOURS-NOTHING-BUT-NET MARATHON STARTS MAY 14<sup>TH</sup>. AND IT WILL BE STREAMED LIVE ON FACEBOOK. NOT ONLY THAT BUT THE EFFORT WILL ALSO BE HAPPENING IN 6 OTHER STATES...ALL FOR SPECIAL OLYMPICS.

#### MAY IS MENTAL HEALTH MONTH

GUEST: JENNIFER ROBERTS...DIRECTOR OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA MENTAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOR CHARLESTON AND DORCHESTER COUNTIES

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON MENTAL HEALTH...AND THE HELP THAT IS AVAILABLE TO THOSE WHO NEED HELP. THE STATEWIDE MENTAL HEALTH HOSPITALS AND CLINICS AROUND THE STATE ARE ALWAYS BUSY...BUT THEY HAVE BEEN BUSIER SINCE THE END OF THE PANDEMIC. ROBERTS SAYS THE TWO YEARS OF LOCKDOWNS AND ISOLATION HAVE BEEN SHOWN TO HAVE AN ADVERSE AFFECT ON MANY...FROM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL KIDS TO THE ELDERLY. SHE SAYS WE WERE PREVENTED FROM SOCIALIZING AND LEADING NORMAL LIVES. THE SITUATION PROMPTED SOME TO SELFMEDICATE WITH DRUGS OR ALCOHOL. FOR OTHERS DEPRESSION WAS THE END RESULT. SELF DESTRUCTIVE BEHAVIORS AND EVEN SUICIDES WERE THE END RESULTS.

BUT THE GOOD NEWS IS THAT THERE IS HELP AVAILABLE. DURING THIS MENTAL HEALTH MONTH...ROBERTS ADVISES THAT IF WE NOTICE FRIENDS ARE 'DIFFERENT' IN THEIR BEHAVIORS...PICK A QUIET TIME AND TALK TO THEM. THEY MAY BE BATTLING FEELINGS THEY DON'T KNOW HOW TO DEAL WITH. THIS MONTH WE ARE ENCOURAGED TO TALK...AND LISTEN.

#### WORKING TO END CHILD TRAFFICKING

<u>AIR DATE:</u> MAY 22, 2022

GUEST: ANDI BURGER...A VICTIM OF CHILD SEX
TRAFFICKING...NOW A WARRIOR AGAINST CHILD TRAFFICKING IN
THE USA

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE GROWING CRIME OF CHILD SEX TRAFFICKING. BURGER SAYS THAT A CHILD IS ABDUCTED EVERY 40 SECONDS NOT OF THEIR OWN WILL AND SOLD INTO A LIFE OF SEX TRAFFICKING. THAT FIGURE COMES FROM THE U-S MARSHALS SERVICE. THE PRIME VICTIM SOUGHT ARE THOSE UNDER THE AGE OF 18.

BOYS AND GIRLS ARE ABDUCTED IN THIS ILLEGAL TRADE...AND THESE YOUNG PEOPLE ARE SELDOM EVER SEEN AGAIN. THEY ARE FED DRUGS AND ARE FORCED INTO SITUATIONS WITH PAYING CUSTOMERS. THESE YOUNG PEOPLE ARE USED AND THEN THROWN AWAY. MANY COMMIT SUICIDE TO FREE THEMSELVES OF THIS HELL THEY HAVE BEEN FORCED TO LIVE.

BURGER'S FIGHT TO BREAK UP CHILD TRAFFICKING RINGS COMES FROM THE FACT THAT SHE WAS TRAFFICKED BY HER MOM WHEN SHE WAS A CHILD.

BURGER SAYS HER MOM WAS NOT WELL...AND TOOK HER PROBLEMS OUT ON ANDI. HER MOM IS DEAD NOW...WHICH SHE SAYS IS A RELIEF. EVEN IF THE WOMAN WAS HER MOM...SHE WAS ALSO HER ABUSER.

# MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND....SAFE BOATING AND GOOD EATS AIR DATE: MAY 29, 2022

PROGRAM 1: SAFE BOATING TIPS FROM THE NATIONAL SAFE BOATING COUNCIL WITH HUNTER BLAND...PROFESSIONAL ANGLER, BOATING ACCIDENT SURVIVOR, AND PROMOTER OF SAFE BOATING PRACTICES

HUNTER BLAND HAS ENJOYED FISHING AND BOATING SINCE THE AGE OF 2. HIS GRANDFATHER WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN FOSTERING THE LOVE OF FISHING AND BOATING. HE GREW UP LEARNING THE RULES OF THE WATER. BUT DURING A FREAK MECHANICAL ACCIDENT WHILE IN A FISHING TOURNAMENT IN COLLEGE...HE SUFFERED SOME INJURIES. BUT HE SAYS IT WOULD HAVE BEEN WORSE IF THE REST OF HIS BOAT WAS NOT IN GOOD WORKING ORDER.

BLAND STRESSES THAT JUST LIKE WITH A CAR...MAINTENANCE IS IMPORTANT AND CUTS DOWN ON PROBLEMS. HE SAYS ITS IMPORTANT TO LEARN THE 'RULES OF THE WATER' AND HOW TO 'DRIVE' ON THE WATER WITH OTHERS. AND HE SAYS THAT WHILE BEER AND OTHER DRINKS ON BOATS HAS BECOME THE NORM...HE STRESSES THAT THE BOATER AT THE CONTROLS MUST SAY SOBER TO INSURE A SAFE TIME ON THE WATER WITH FRIENDS.

PROGRAM 2: AFTER A DAY ON THE WATER...GATHER WITH FRIENDS FOR A COOK OUT WITH CHEF REBECCA LANG. SHE IS A COOK BOOK AUTHOR...COOKING TEACHER AND WRITES FOR THE JAMES BEARD FOUNDATION BLOG.

REBECCA SAYS THAT DESPITE INFLATION TAKING BITES OUT OF OUR WALLET...WE CAN STILL ENTERTAIN FRIENDS OVER THE MEMORIAL DAY HOLIDAY WEEKEND. CHS4UKRAINE IS A WEBSITE STARTED TO INFORM EVERYONE ON HOW THEY CAN HELP UKRAINIAN REFUGEES WHO'VE HAD TO FLEE TO POLAND.

MAROLDA'S MOTHER HAS ROOTS IN UKRAINE AND HE HAS MADE SEVERAL TRIPS TO POLAND TO MEET THE REFUGEES AND DELIVER ITEMS SUCH AS CLOTHING...FOODS...BABY NEEDS...AND TRAUMA KITS. THEY ARE MINI FIRST AID KITS.

THE UKRAINIAN COMMUNITY IN CHARLESTON IS ABOUT 500 STRONG. EURO FOODS IN WEST ASHLEY IS ALSO HELPING IN THIS EFFORT. AND THE EFFORT CONTINUES TO GROW.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE WORK OF THE FATHER-TO-FATHER ORGANIZATION. NOT ALL DADS REFLECT THE IMAGES WE'VE SEEN ON TELEVISION. SOME DADS HAVE A ROUGHER START IN LIFE...THEY HAVE RUN-INS WITH THE LAW...THEY GO THRU UGLY DIVORCES AND FALL BEHIND IN CHILD SUPPORT PAYMENTS. NOT ALL DADS ARE ALIKE.

FATHER-TO-FATHER WORKS TO HELP FATHERS WHO WANT TO CHANGE THEIR LIFE AND GENERATE MORE POSITIVE OUTCOMES FOR THEIR KIDS AND FOR THEMSELVES.

FATHER-TO-FATHER REQUIRES A SERIOUS COMMITMENT FROM THE FATHERS WHO WANT TO TRULY CHANGE. THIS REQUIRES THEY ATTEND CLASSES AND LEARN HOW TO MAKE BETTER CHOICES IN LIFE. THESE CLASSES MAY INCLUDE ANGER MANAGEMENT CLASSES. AND THERE ARE CLASSES THAT TEACH BETTER TECHNIQUES IN DEALING WITH EX-WIVES. SWAZIGGER SAYS THAT MANY TIMES...THIS ONE ASPECT DERAILS EFFORTS FOR A FATHER TO START UP MEANINGFUL RELATIONSHIPS WITH THEIR KIDS.

STUDIES HAVE SHOWN THAT KIDS WHO HAVE A STRONG POSITIVE FATHER IN THEIR LIVES DO BETTER IN SCHOOL...ARE MORE LIKELY

TO GO TO COLLEGE...AND HAVE A MORE POSITIVE LIFE. DADS MATTER.
