<u>GUEST:</u> TOSHA CONNERS...EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF MY SISTER'S HOUSE...A BATTERED WOMEN'S RESOURCE

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON EVENTS PLANNED DURING OCTOBER WHICH IS DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH. THE IDEA IS TO DRAW ATTENTION TO THE CONTINUING PROBLEM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

ITS BELIEVED THAT THE MORE AWARENESS THERE IS...THE MORE PEOPLE WILL BE ABLE TO HELP THOSE SUSPECTED OF DEALING WITH VIOLENCE IN THEIR HOME...AT THE HAND OF SOMEONE THEY LOVE. EXPERTS SAY ITS ALL VERY COMPLICATED WHEN IT COMES FROM THE ABUSED LEAVING THEIR ABUSER.

THERE ARE SEVERAL EVENTS PLANNED THIS MONTH TO HELP THE PUBLIC UNDERSTAND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND HOW INDIVIDUALS CAN HELP.

THE GLIMMER OF GOOD NEWS IS ALL OF THIS...IS THAT SOUTH CAROLINA IS NOT IN THE TOP 10 ANYMORE WHEN IT COMES TO WOMEN MURDERED BY MEN THEY KNOW. SOUTH CAROLINA IS NOT EVEN IN THE TOP 5...AS WE'VE BEEN IN THE PAST. IN THE CURRENT STATS SOUTH CAROLINA RANKED NUMBER 23 IN THE NATION.

THE NUMBERS SHOW THE STATE MAY BE MAKING SOME PROGRESS (FINALLY) WHEN IT COMES TO SOLVING THIS SOCIETAL PROBLEM.

WHY DO THIS WORK THRU COFFEE? JOHN SAYS COFFEE IS THE BEVERAGE MOST EVERYONE ENJOYS. ITS AN EQUALIZER. EVERYONE APPRECIATES A GOOD HOT CUP OF COFFEE...ESPECIALLY VETERANS AND FIRST RESPONDERS. IT'S A DRINK THAT GIVES US THE URGE TO POWER THROUGH OUR TASKS. EVERYONE APPRECIATES COFFEE.

THEY DECIDED TO USE THEIR COFFEE BUSINESS TO ALSO RAISE MONEY FOR VETS AND FIRST RESPONDERS. THE ONE NATION FOUNDATION WORKS WITH LIKE-MINDED ORGANIZATIONS TO DO THIS WORK.

THE FOUNDATION IS HOLDING A GOLF TOURNAMENT OCT 13<sup>TH</sup> AT SUMMERVILLE COUNTRY CLUB...TO RAISE MONEY FOR THEIR ORGANIZATION'S EFFORTS AND INVITE VETERAN AND FIRST RESPONDER TEAMS TO PARTICIPATE.

#### THE HISPANIC BUSINESS EXPO

AIR DATE: OCTOBER 16, 2022

GUEST: ED BROWN OF NELSON BROWN CONSULTING AND ORGANIZER OF THE FIRST ANNUAL HISPANIC BUSINESS EXPO

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE HISPANIC BUSINESS EXPO WHICH HAPPENS SUNDAY OCTOBER 23<sup>RD</sup> AT THE OPPORTUNITY CENTER ON RIVERS AVE. THIS IS THE FIRST BUSINESS EXPO OF ITS KIND FOR THE GROWING HISPANIC COMMUNITY. THE HISPANIC COMMUNITY COMES TO THE LOW COUNTRY WITH IDEAS TO OPEN BUSINESSES.

BROWN SAYS THIS GROWING COMMUNITY DOESN'T JUST WANT TO OPEN RESTAURANTS. MANY HAVE FLOORING...PLUMBING...MECHANICAL AND OTHER SKILLS. THEY WANT TO WORK FOR THEMSELVES AND LIVE THEIR OWN AMERICAN DREAM BY WORKING FOR THEMSELVES. BUT GOOD IDEAS DO NOT ALWAYS WORK.

BROWN SAYS THE EXPO WILL INTRODUCE HISPANICS TO THE 'HARD WORK' IT TAKES TO OPEN A BUSINESS. FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS IS TO HAVE A SOLID BUSINESS PLAN AND LINING UP FINANCING. OFTEN TIMES THERE IS A LANGUAGE BARRIER THAT CAN BE A CHALLENGE. THE HISPANIC EXPO WILL INTRODUCE THOSE WHO WANT TO START A BUSINESS WITH THE TOOLS THEY NEED TO GET A GOOD IDEA OFF THE GROUND. THE EXPO ALSO WORKS TO GUARD HISPANICS AGAINST CHARACTERS THAT MAY TRY AND SWINDLE THEIR IDEA.

THE EXPO IS MEANT TO BE A GREAT FIRST STOP FOR THOSE WHO WANT TO START A BUSINESS.

THE HISPANIC BUSINESS EXPO IS A FREE EVENT AND ANYONE CAN ATTEND TO LEARN ABOUT BUSINESS OR TO LEARN ABOUT THE HISPANIC CULTURE. THERE WILL BE FOOD TRUCKS AND JUMP CASTLES FOR THE KIDS...ALONG WITH MUSIC.

THE GOVERNMENT WILL LIFT THE COVID HEALTH CARE
EMERGENCY IN A FEW WEEKS. WHAT IT MEANS FOR YOUR HEALTH
INSURANCE

OUR 10 MINUTE DISCUSSION CENTERED ON WHAT THE LIFTING OF THE COVID PANDEMIC NATIONAL EMERGENCY WILL MEAN FOR YOUR HEALTH INSURANCE.

THE GOVERNMENT HAS BEEN PAYING FOR COVID SHOTS AND BOOSTERS...TESTING KITS...AND EVEN PROTECTIVE GEAR SUCH AS MASKS. WHEN THE NATIONAL EMERGENCY IS FINALLY LIFTED...LIKELY BY JANUARY 2023...THOSE COSTS WILL GO TO THE CONSUMER. CAMERON ADVISES THAT NOW IS THE TIME TO CHECK YOUR CURRENT POLICIES TO INSURE FUTURE SHOTS ARE COVERED.

IT'S ALSO MEDICARE ENROLLMENT PERIOD...NOW THRU EARLY DECEMBER. CAMERON HIGHLY SUGGESTS THAT IF YOU ARE LOOKING FOR A PLAN...SHOP LOCALLY.

HE ALSO SAYS IT IS VITALLY IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTAND YOUR POLICIES AND KNOW WHAT THEY COVER SO THERE ARE NO SURPRISES SHOWING UP IN THE MAIL IN THE FORM OF BILLS.

FINALLY...CAMERON URGES THAT IF ANY CONSUMER OF HEALTH INSURANCE FEELS THEY ARE NOT GETTING WHAT THEY PAID

FOR...HE OR SHE SHOULD CALL THEIR STATE'S INSURANCE COMMISSIONER. HE SAYS THE JOB OF THAT OFFICIAL IS TO PROTECT CONSUMERS AGAINST SHADY PRACTICES. AND HE SAYS THOSE OFFICES ARE REQUIRED BY LAW TO HELP CONSUMERS.

# THE LONON FOUNDATION...HELPING KIDS COPE WITH CANCER AIR DATE: OCTOBER 23, 2022

GUEST: ANNA LONON...FOUNDER OF THE LONON FOUNDATION

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE LONON FOUNDATION...WHICH WAS CREATED BY ANNA LONON AFTER HER HUSBAND RECEIVED A CANCER DIAGNOSIS. AT THE AGE OF 29...MIKE LONON FOUND OUT HE HAD CANCER. HE DIED AT THE AGE OF 32.

DESPITE PUTTING UP A BRAVE AND CONFIDENT FRONT...BOTH WERE WORRIED ABOUT HOW HIS DEATH WOULD AFFECT THEIR KIDS. ONE WAS JUST THREE MONTHS OLD...AND WOULD NOT REMEMBER HER FATHER. BUT THEIR SON WAS 4. HE DID GO THRU A LOT OF ADJUSTMENT AND EVEN ANGER WHEN HIS FATHER DIED.

THE LONON FOUNDATION WORKS WITH ROPER HOSPITAL AND CAME UP WITH A SERIES OF 'BOOKS' ON HOW TO TALK TO KIDS ABOUT CANCER AND LOSING A PARENT. ALL THE MATERIALS ARE AGE APPROPRIATE AND HELP A CHILD WITH LITTLE UNDERSTANDING OF CANCER.

ANNA LONON SAYS PEOPLE WHO THINK KIDS ARE RESILIENT ARE WRONG. HER SON...AT THE AGE OF 4...HAD ANGER ISSUES. HE'S OLDER NOW...BUT IS STILL VERY SENSITIVE ABOUT THE ORDEAL OF LOSING HIS DAD.

THE LONON FOUNDATION ALSO SCHEDULES EVENTS THAT KIDS CAN ATTEND...TO HELP COPE WITH THE LOSS OF A PARENT. ANNA LONON SAYS THE IMPORTANT MESSAGE FOR THESE KIDS ...AGES 5 TO 17...IS THAT THEY ARE NOT ALONE. THEY ARE WITH OTHER KIDS

WHO ARE GOING THRU THE SAME LOSS. IT GIVES THEM A PLACE TO TALK ABOUT THEIR LOSS WITH OTHER KIDS.

THE LONON FOUNDATION HAS AN EVENT COMING UP ON OCTOBER  $29^{\text{TH}}$ ...INVITING PARENTS AND THEIR KIDS TO ATTEND FOR FUN GAMES FOR THE KIDS...AND A NICE RAFFLE FOR THE ADULTS. THE MONEY RAISED WILL HELP THE FOUNDATION CONTINUE ITS WORK

#### ANONYMOUS ANCESTORS EXHIBIT AT THE CITY GALLERY

AIR DATE: OCTOBER 30, 2022

<u>GUEST:</u> SUSAN LENZ...SOUTH CAROLINA ARTIST AND CREATOR OF THE ANONYMOUS ANCESTORS EXHIBIT...OPENING AT THE CITY GALLERY DOWNTOWN FROM OCTOBER 28-JANUARY 29, 2023

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE LENZ EXHIBIT FEATURING OLD PHOTOGRAPHS OBTAINED THRU ESTATE SALES. LENZ BECAME INTERESTED IN WHO THESE PEOPLE IN THE OLD FADED PICTURES WERE...WHAT THEY DID...AND HOW THEY LIVED. HUNDREDS OF PICTURES ARE ON DISPLAY IN THESE EXHIBITS.

SHE NOTED THAT SOME OF THE PICTURES DATE BACK TO THE 1800s. PICTURES WERE NOT EASY TO TAKE OVER THE DECADES. CAMERAS WERE EXPENSIVE AND UNLESS YOU WERE IN THE NEWSPAPER OR A CHURCH BULLETIN YOU MIGHT NOT HAVE HAD A PICTURE TAKEN OF YOUR FAMILY. SOME OF THE PICTURES WERE SCHOOL PICTURES AND OF COURSE SCHOOLS PAID FOR THOSE.

OVER THE DECADES...FAMILIES OFTEN TOOK PICTURES OF THEMSELVES STANDING WITH THEIR FIRST CAR. SOMETIMES THERE ARE FAMILY PICTURES OF A FAMILY WELCOMING A NEW BABY TO THE FAMILY. BUT FOR MANY...ROUTINE PHOTOGRAPHS WERE NOT THE NORM.

SURPRISINGLY...MANY NEVER WROTE ON THE BACK OF THE PHOTO WHEN IT WAS TAKEN AND WHO WAS IN THE SHOT. LENZ SAYS IT DIMINISHES LATER GENERATIONS WHO LATER FOUND THE BOX OF

OLD PHOTOGRAPHS AND WONDERED WHO THESE OLD RELATIVES OR FRIENDS OF THE FAMILY WERE.

THE EXHIBIT AT THE CITY GALLERY IS SET IN WHAT LENZ DESCRIBES AS A PARLOR...LIKE THE ONE YOUR GREAT GRANDMOTHER MAY HAVE HAD IN HER HOME. THERE IS A LOT OF OLD FURNISHINGS AND EMBROIDERIES AND STITCH PROJECTS. IT'S ALL MEANT TO ADD TO THE AGE OF THE PHOTOGRAPHS THRU THE AGES.

#### A WEEKEND ABOUT MILITARY VETERANS

AIR DATE: NOVEMBER 6, 2022

<u>GUEST:</u> DENISE CROMWELL....EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF PROJECT STREET OUTREACH

AND CHRIS HAUFF...MARKETING AND COMMUNICATIONS DIRECTOR FOR PATRIOTS POINT MILITARY MUSEUM IN MT PLEASANT

THE FIRST 20 MINUTES OF THIS PROGRAM PROJECT STREET OUTREACH WAS DISCUSSED. CROMWELL HAS A SOFT SPOT IN HER HEART FOR AN UNCLE WHO COULD NOT ADJUST TO LIFE OUTSIDE THE MILITARY. HE ENDED UP COMMITTING SUICIDE ABOUT 30 YEARS AGO. SHE CREATED 'PROJECT STREET OUTREACH' TO HELP HOMELESS VETS WHO ARE HAVING A DIFFICULT TIME TRANSITIONING FROM MILITARY TO CIVILIAN LIFE. THE ORGANIZATION IS GETTING READY TO CELEBRATE THANKSGIVING LATER THIS MONTH AT MT MORIAH MISSIONARY CHURCH IN NORTH CHARLESTON ON NOVEMBER 19<sup>TH</sup>. VETERANS WILL GET A TRADITIONAL THANKSGIVING MEAL...AND RESOURCES TO HELP THEM BEGIN TO GET BACK ON THEIR FEET. THOSE RESOURCES CAN BE EVERYTHING FROM A HAIRCUT TO JOB TRAINING.

ALSO DISCUSSED...THE RAVAGES OF PTSD...POST TRAUMATIC STRESS SYNDROME. SHE SAYS SO MANY VETERANS BATTLE WITH PTSD...AND IT MAKES IT DIFFICULT FOR VETS TO HAVE A SUCCESSFUL TRANSITION TO CIVILIAN LIFE. SHE HOPES A THANKSGIVING MEAL THEY GET WILL HELP 'CENTER' AND COMFORT THEM IN THEIR MENTAL STRUGGLES.

PART TWO OF THIS WEEK'S CAROLINA PERSPECTIVE IS WITH PATRIOTS POINT'S CHRIS HAUFF. HE GIVES OUR LISTENERS INFORMATION ON VETERANS DAY WEEKEND. THE MILITARY MUSEUM IS PLANNING A SLATE OF EVENTS FOR VETS. FREE ADMISSION AND DISPLAYS AND PROGRAMS.

ONE INTERESTING EVENT HAPPENS SATURDAY NOVEMBER 12<sup>TH</sup>. IT'S A WATERCOLOR PAINTING EVENT. LOW COUNTRY ARTIST MARY WHYTE IS RETURNING TO THE CARRIER YORKTOWN TO SHOW VETERANS HOW TO PAINT IN WATERCOLORS. SHE WILL COACH THEM TO PAINT...AND THE VETS ARE EXCITED ABOUT LEARNING.

ALSO THE CITADEL'S SUMMERALL GUARDS WILL PERFORM A SILENT PRECISION DRILL ON THE YORKTOWN'S FLIGHT DECK. HAUFF SAYS IT'S A TRADITIONAL DRILL THAT HAS NEVER BEEN WRITTEN DOWN. IT'S A DRILL THAT HAS BEEN PASSED DOWN TO CADETS THRU THE DECADES. MORE EVENTS CAN BE FOUND AT THE PATRIOTS POINT WEBSITE.

THIS YEAR ON NOVEMBER 22<sup>ND</sup>...THOSE AT ONE 80 PLACE SHELTER AND KITCHEN...WILL TAKE THE PUBLIC'S DONATIONS OF TURKEYS OR HAMS OR NON PERISHABLE FOOD AND A KINDLY MONETARY DONATION (the suggestion is a \$20 bill) TO HELP STOCK THE SHELTER'S KITCHEN AND ENSURE ALL HAVE A NICE THANKSGIVING DINNER. GROCERY STORE GIFT CARDS ARE ALSO APPRECIATED TO HELP THOSE FAMILIES IN HOMES BUT CAN'T AFFORD A TURKEY AND TRIMMINGS FOR A NICE THANKSGIVING DINNER.

WE ALSO DISCUSSED THE WORK ONE 80 PLACE HAS BEEN DOING IN DOWNTOWN CHARLESTON SINCE 1984. THE SHELTER IS THE TEMPORARY HOME OF ABOUT 400 INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES NIGHTLY...UNTIL THOSE INDIVIDUALS CAN GET BACK ON THEIR FEET AND HAVE A PLACE TO STAY.

IT'S ALL MEANT TO PREVENT HOMELESSNESS AND FIND HOMES FOR THOSE WHO HAVE LOST THEIR HOMES...ESPECIALLY FOLLOWING THE COVID PANDEMIC.

THE MONEY COLLECTED ON NOVEMBER 22<sup>ND</sup> WILL KEEP THE KITCHEN OPEN...ALONG WITH HELP FROM THE DOWNTOWN BUSINESS AND RESTAURANT COMMUNITY.

THE ZUCKER FAMILY COMMUNITY KITCHEN AT THE SHELTER WORKS 365 DAYS A YEAR...TURNING OUT MEALS. IT NEVER CLOSES.

HELP FROM THE COMMUNITY IS ALWAYS APPRECIATED...ANYTIME OF THE YEAR.

GOVERNOR HENRY MCMASTER DECLARED NOVEMBER THE MONTH OF THE CAREGIVER IN SOUTH CAROLINA. AND THE ARK OF SOUTH CAROLINA IS ALL ABOUT CONSIDERING THE CAREGIVER TAKING CARE OF A LOVED ONE.

INTERESTING TO NOTE THAT CAREGIVERS USED TO BE MOSTLY WOMEN. BUT THE ARK SAYS MORE AND MORE MEN ARE STEPPING UP TO TAKE CARE OF A PARENT OR WIFE SUFFERING STAGES OF MEMORY ROBBING DISEASES. THERE IS ALSO AN EMPHASIS ON RELIGION...AS CSU IS AFFILIATED WITH THE SOUTHERN BAPTIST CHURCH. THOUGH...A RELIGIOUS CONVICTION IS OT A PREREQUISITE FOR ENROLLMENT.

ALSO...TIME WAS SPENT ON THE SCAMMERS THAT COME OUT THIS TIME OF YEAR. FISCHER SAYS DOMINION ENERGY WILL NEVER CALL YOU DEMANDING PAYMENT IN GIFT CARDS OR GREEN DOT CARDS. DOMINION CONTACTS RATEPAYERS BY MAIL. IF ONE GETS A CALL FROM SOMEONE PRETENDING TO BE A DOMINION ENERGY BILL COLLECTOR...HANG UP. IT IS A SCAMMER.

DOMINION ENERGY IS CURRENTLY ASKING STATE REGULATORS FOR A RATE HIKE. THE UTILITY KNOWS NO ONE LIKES RATE HIKES. FISCHER SAYS IF BILLS BECOME OVERWHELMING...JUST CALL DOMINION. THE UTILITY IS WILLING TO WORK WITH RATEPAYERS.

THE SECOND PART OF THIS WEEK'S CAROLINA PERSPECTIVE CONSISTED OF A 10 MINUTE CHAT WITH DR KIMBERLY SMITH. SHE IS WITH VIIV (veev) HEALTHCARE. DECEMBER FIRST MARKS WORLD AIDS DAY. THE DOCTOR'S MESSAGE WAS THAT THE DAY SHOULD BE SPENT TESTING FOR THE HIGHLY INFECTIOUS DISEASE. SMITH SAYS THERE IS STILL A SOLID STIGMA WHEN IT COMES TO TESTING. SHE SAYS TESTING AND EDUCATION IS ESSENTIAL TO COMBATTING THIS DISEASE.

SHE ALSO TALKED ABOUT THE NEW PRESCRIPTION MEDICINES ON THE MARKET THAT....IF TAKEN AS PRESCRIBED....CAN MAKE IT IMPOSSIBLE TO PASS HIV INFECTION TO OTHERS. IT IS NOT A CURE...BUT CLOSE.

BUT SHE SAYS THE MEDICINES MUST INCLUDE LIFESTYLE AND SEXUAL BEHAVIORAL CHANGES. THE IDEA IS TO MAKE HIV SCARCE. BUT NEW INFECTIONS ARE DIAGNOSED EVERY DAY. SHE ALSO SAYS MOST OF THE NEW CASES ARE COMING FROM THE SOUTHERN STATES...PERHAPS BECAUSE THE STIGMA IS GREATER IN THE SOUTH.

## MOMS FOR LIBERTY...WORKING TO MAKE SCHOOLS EDUCATE AND NOT INDOCTRINATE

GUEST: TARA WOOD...PRESIDENT OF MOMS FOR LIBERTY

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THIS GRASSROOTS CHAPTER OF A NATIONAL MOVEMENT TO GET THE NATION'S PUBLIC SCHOOLS TEACHING REAL EDUCATION...AND NOT EXPLORING STUDENTS' GENDER AND SEXUALITY ISSUES OR PERVERTING HISTORY WITH A HEAVY-HANDED EMPHASIS ON SLAVERY.

MOMS FOR LIBERTY STARTED DURING THE SCHOOL LOCKDOWNS OF COVID. PARENTS WERE ABLE TO SEE WHAT TEACHERS WERE TEACHING KIDS. THIS DEALT MOSTLY WITH CRITICAL RACE THEORY. THAT'S CAUSED A FIRESTORM OF CONTROVERSY COAST TO COAST. THE LOCAL MOMS FOR LIBERTY WERE ABLE TO FLIP THE CHARLESTON CO SCHOOL BOARD TO HOPEFULLY CHANGE CURRENT STUDIES THAT BRUSH UP AGAINST C-R-T.

THE OTHER MAJOR CONCERN IS WHAT IS BEING CALLED THE 'GROOMING' OF STUDENTS BY ADULTS WHO ARE TRYING TO GET YOUR YOUNGEST STUDENTS THINKING SEXUALLY. FROM GENDER TRANSFORMATION TO DRAG QUEEN STORY TIME TO PUTTING SEXUALLY CHARGED BOOKS IN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LIBRARIES...MOMS FOR LIBERTY IS KEEPING TABS ON IT ALL.

THE LOCAL LOW COUNTY CHAPTER HAS ATTRACTED UP TO 500 PARENTS WHO ARE EXPRESSING THE SAME CONCERNS ABOUT PUBLIC EDUCATION AND WHAT'S HAPPENING IN THE SCHOOLS.

THEY WANT ACTUAL LESSONS TAUGHT SO STUDENTS CAN COMPETE IN THE WORLD OF

MATH...SCIENCE...TECHNOLOGY...READING...AND HISTORY...WITHOUT ALL THE ONE-SIDED COMENTARY.

### THE CONTINUING EFFORT FOR SOUTH CAROLINA'S WACCAMAW TRIBE TO GAIN FEDERAL RECOGNITION

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE CONTINUING EFFORT FOR THE WACCAMAW TRIBE TO GAIN FEDERAL RECOGNITION.
RECENTLY...THE BIDEN ADMINISTRATION HOSTED THE FIRST INPERSON SUMMIT ON TRIBAL AFFAIRS IN THE PAST 6 YEARS. DURING THE SUMMIT THE GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCED IT'S GIVING TRIBES MILLIONS OF DOLLARS IN AN EFFORT TO HELP HEAL ANY ENVIRONMENTAL HARM OR DAMAGE CAUSED BY CLIMATE CHANGE.

THE WACCAMAW...AND OTHER TRIBES AROUND THE COUNTRY ARE NOT AMONG THE FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED NATIVE AMERICAN TRIBES IN AMERICA. CHIEF HATCHER SAYS IT'S NOT FAIR TO HAVE TO PROVE YOU ARE NATIVE TO THE COUNTRY...WHEN IT IS CLEAR FROM THE HISTORY BOOKS...DOCUMENTS... AND STATE RECOGNITION.

THE EFFORTS HOWEVER CONTINUE TO GAIN FEDERAL RECOGNITION. THE CHIEF SUGGESTS A MASSIVE LETTER WRITING CAMPAIGN TO THE WHITE HOUSE. THE TRIBE TAKES THIS ALL VERY PERSONALLY. AND EFFORTS WILL CONTINUE TO BE RECOGNIZED AS A NATIVE AMERICAN TRIBE. HATCHER SAYS ITS NOT ABOUT THE MONEY. IT'S ABOUT RESPECT...AND THE FACT THAT HE AND THE TRIBE ARE AMERICANS.
