Quarterly Ascertainment Summary – 4th Quarter 2019

Attached is a report concerning KEZI-TV news stories, local programming, network programming and public service announcements aired by KEZI during 4th Quarter 2019, pertaining to key issues as determined by the KEZI -TV Community Relations department.

The five main areas and issues listed below are identified from viewer comments, solicited community comment and ascertainment of interviews with community leaders.

KEZI Key Issues:

1. Crime and Community Safety
2. Kids / Education / Parenting
3. Traffic / Transportation
4. Government / Environmental Planning
5. Land Use / Community Growth

Public Service Announcements:

KEZI-TV Eugene contributed **1,418** public service announcements covering issues in the station’s immediate community, and across Lane, Linn, Douglas, Benton and Coos Counties. KEZI-TV also contributed a minimum of one story per 30 minutes of news covering the above issues (samples on DVD available on individual request).

KEZI-TV+ (KRBG - Roseburg / Coos Bay / Corvallis) contributed **3,033** public service announcements covering issues in outlying areas of Douglas, Coos and Benton Counties. KEZI-TV+ (KRBG) also contributed a minimum of one story per 30 minutes of news covering the above issues (samples on DVD available on individual request).

KEZI 9.2 (Eugene + Limited DMA Viewing) contributed **1,289** public service announcements covering key community issues across KEZI's DMA.

Emergency Alert System:

KEZI-TV Eugene and KEZI-TV+ (KRBG - Roseburg / Coos Bay / Corvallis) are participating stations in the Oregon and Clark, WA, Operational Area Emergency Alert System. A total of **25** weekly EAS tests and 3 monthly EAS tests covering Lane, Benton, Coos and Douglas County aired.

KEZI 9.2 is a participating station in the Oregon and Clark, WA Operational Area Emergency Alert System. A total of **25** weekly EAS tests and 3 monthly EAS tests covering Eugene and limited DMA viewing aired.

KEZI 9.3 is a participating station in the Oregon and Clark, WA Operational Area Emergency Alert System. A total of **25** weekly EAS tests and a total of 3 monthly EAS tests covering Eugene and limited DMA viewing aired.

During 4th Quarter 2019, one Amber Alert was broadcast on KEZI-TV Eugene, KEZI-TV+, KEZI 9.2 and KEZI 9.3.

There is a significant need for skilled workers in the counties that KEZI-TV serves. In 4th Quarter 2019, KEZI 9 News continued our *Skilled to Work* educational campaign. In partnership with key industries across our market, KEZI 9 News shared apprenticeship information, job opportunities, educational resources, and helped connect employers with workers interested in skilled labor positions across Western Oregon. KEZI continues to develop and update a comprehensive online portal at KEZI.COM, produce and broadcast *Skilled to Work* reports every week on KEZI 9 News, and has dedicated significant inventory to promote the initiative on-air and across all digital platforms.

During Q4, KEZI 9 News partnered with businesses and non-profits to collect food, clothing, blankets, toys, and provide financial assistance for the less fortunate through several local station initiatives. KEZI donated significant on-air time and inventory during multiple drive days to support them. KEZI's ThanksGIVING Food Drive collected canned food for the Relief Nursery, which helps feed families in need throughout Western Oregon. KEZI 9 News continued its support for Toys for Tots, partnering with the U.S. Marine Corps and local retailers to collect thousands of toys and money for local families and children. KEZI's Warm Winter Nights drive helped raise much needed clothes, blankets, and necessities for the Eugene Mission, which serves a growing homeless population in Western Oregon. And KEZI's Santa's Little Helpers campaign collected books, toys, diapers and funds to help local foster children through the Bags of Love charity.

Tourism is a large part of the local economy. KEZI supports local community expo & tourism boards, and sponsors many unique community events. During Q4, KEZI sponsored the Corvallis Christmas Parade, Eugene Symphony, Umpqua Festival of Lights, McKenzie Cider & Craft Beer Festival, and Corvallis Pastega Christmas Lights Display, among others. KEZI also airs four weekly on-going news segments that highlight high school sports, pet adoption, environmental sustainability, and many community events of interest through our online and on-air community calendars. KEZI also helps support important community non-profits and charities by promoting their special initiatives throughout the year. During the 4th Quarter, KEZI talent supported key fundraising and community involvement events for the Walk to End Alzheimer's, Eugene Civic Alliance Day of

Play, Kidsports Foundation recruitment for children's sports, and the 20 Under 40 Awards which recognize local young business leaders making a difference in our community.

KEZI has partnered with local towing companies to bring awareness to roadside traffic safety with the Move Over campaign. KEZI produced and ran messages on-air and online to inform drivers about Oregon's Move Over law, and the need to both slow down and change lanes when approaching vehicles with hazard lights on the side of the road. KEZI also participated in the national Project Roadblock public service campaign to stop DUIs.

Health issues are always a concern for viewers, and KEZI is helping to raise awareness and promote healthy living choices through partnerships with the McKenzie Heart Group, Community Cancer Center, Oregon Urology Institute and Bay Area Hospital. On the 9th day of each month, KEZI 9 News produces informative cancer-focused interview segments to remind at-risk viewers to self-check for common forms of cancer during KEZI 9 *Checks In*.
