Dear Affiliate Partner:

To assist you in complying with the reporting requirements for children's television and the requirement that stations air "core" children's programming, we are providing you with episode-specific descriptions (the 'NBC Kids' educational and informational programming block) as set forth in the attached Community Relations Quarterly Children's Programming Report for the 1st quarter of 2014. The report includes information to help prepare FCC Form 398. Please note that we have not included the specific dates and times for each of the programs as that may be station-specific.

This report is divided into the following categories:

1. Educational Objectives: NBC Kids for both 1st quarter 2014 and 2nd quarter 2014.
2. Core programming: Regularly scheduled programming furnished by the NBC Network that is specifically designed to serve the early educational and informational needs of children 16 and under. Each of these programs is identified on-air as educational and informational with the "E/I" icon, and is similarly identified to the national listing services. To assist stations with the preemption report section of FCC Form 398, we have added specific episode numbers. Please note that the age target for NBC Kids programming is identified as 2-5 years old.
3. Other programming: Programming furnished by the NBC Network that contributes to the educational and informational needs of children 16 and under, but is not specifically designed to meet the educational and informational needs of children.
4. Public service announcements targeted to children 16 and under.
5. Non-broadcast efforts that enhance the educational and informational value of NBC Network programming to children.
6. Network on-air promotional efforts, which include a schedule of NBC on-air promos for NBC Kids programming.

The regularly-scheduled children's programming and promotional content furnished to you by the NBC Network during the 1st quarter of 2014 complied with the commercial limits of the Children's Television Act, and 47 C.F.R. §§ 73.670(a)-(d), provided that you broadcast and distributed such programming as furnished to you by NBC, and did not add any promotional or advertising content thereto other than as directed by NBC via weekly postings on APT.

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1st QUARTER 2014 EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

In compliance with the Children's Television Act regulations that became effective January 2, 1997, the **NBC kids** programming block features an on-air icon (E/I) indicating that each program is "educational and informational" for children. **This icon is displayed throughout each program.** Also, in compliance with the regulations, the following document, which includes "early educational and informational" objectives of **NBC kids**, must be placed in your public file.

The **NBC kids** programming block also meets the requirements for video described content, as established by the Twenty-first Century Communications and Video Accessibility Act, effective October 8, 2010. Full-power affiliates of NBC that are located in the 25 television markets with the largest number of television households must provide video-described content at any time they are providing children's programming. Each episode of content can be aired no more than twice in the calendar year.

Each of the programs listed below, which make up the three hour **NBC kids** programming block, is specifically designed to serve the early educational and informational needs of children ages 2-5. All of the programs have educational objectives and messages that are core to the content and appropriate for the program genre.

From January 4, 2014 – March 29, 2014, **NBC Kids** aired five shows returning from the 4th Quarter 2013. These are: **The Chica Show**, **Justin Time**, **Tree Fu Tom**, **Lazy Town** and **Make Way for Noddy**. The sixth show, **Noodle and Doodle**, entered the schedule January 4, 2014.

All six shows were developed specifically for a target audience composed of children ages 2-5. All but one of the shows (**Noodle and Doodle**) have a narrative format. Three (**Justin Time**, **The Chica Show** and **Tree Fu Tom**) use elements of fantasy and imagination to develop the educational content. **The Chica Show** and **Tree Fu Tom** combine live action with animation; **Lazy Town** is live action with puppets, **Justin** and **Noddy** are animated, and **Noodle and Doodle** is a live action, fact based craft and cooking show.

The Chica Show features a five-year-old "baby" chick who spends her days with her parents in their costume shop, the Coop. The shop's one employee, Kelly, doubles as Chica's nanny and the ensemble is rounded out with Bunji, a large floppy eared rabbit and Stitches, a straw mannequin that sits in the window. In each episode Chica develops or encounters a problem that she cannot immediately resolve. Usually her issues involve impulse control, distractibility, judgment, and inter-personal behaviors. She and Kelly usually work on the problem through an adventure—a fantasy transformation to animation-- where Bunji and Stitches come alive and join Chica and Kelly for the problem solving process. The core educational content is primarily socio-emotional development, and Chica learns how to express herself properly, think before she acts, and interact with others effectively. She often learns that it takes hard work and practice to become proficient at different skills.

Noodle and Doodle, an instructional series, features creating art projects and cooking projects around a specific theme. Host, Sean, drives around in a double-decker bus fully equipped with art supplies and a kitchen, ready for any assignment. The projects encourage parent engagement and often feature families working together to make something to display within the child's home. Sean's side-kick, Doggity, is an ever-faithful beagle who transforms into an animated character

during interstitial trips to a parallel universe, set in a kitchen full of prank playing animated characters. The art projects typically promote utilizing recycled materials in order to demonstrate that creativity can transform something intended for one purpose into something that achieves a completely different goal.

Justin Time features a little boy, Justin, who wants very much to master his destiny, have great adventures, and solve problems. He begins with a problem that vexes him and daydreams his way into an adventure that takes him to different places around the world, providing him with an experience to help solve his problem when he returns home. Justin is accompanied by two imaginary friends throughout his adventures; Olive, a knowledgeable playmate, and Squidgy, the morphing flying sponge, who provides commentary and comedy along the way. Some examples of Justin's lessons involve learning that it takes focus to achieve success, our failures can teach what we need to do to succeed next time, or when one path to solve a problem doesn't work, you can find an alternative way to achieve your goal. Justin promotes self-directed learning from the young child's perspective and imagination.

Tree Fu Tom is a live action/animated series about a little boy who lives in a rural area and has a rich fantasy life in the woods behind his home. Tom uses specific movements to summon up magic powers that permit him to morph into an animated hero and fly around in Treetopolis, the fantasy version of his woods. While in Treetopolis, Tom and his friends, Ariella, Twigs, Squirmturn and Zigzoo will invariably run into a problem or disaster that needs fixing. Tom calls upon the audience to practice original dance moves that will bring him "Big World" magic so he and his friends can resolve their challenge of the day. Educational messages reinforce positive socio-emotional content, with examples that model: being loyal to good friends, knowing how to ask for help, doing the right thing instead of what is convenient, making the effort to share rather than being selfish or relying on teamwork in order to accomplish a goal.

Lazy Town encourages fitness and healthful habits for preschool children. In the imaginary setting of Lazy Town, characters' eating and fitness habits are linked to problem solving in their world. The lead character is Stephanie, a young girl who guides the audience through the story as she and her friends ("human" puppets) and her Uncle (Mayor Milford Meanswell) navigate life within Lazy Town. Robbie Rotten, the underground spy and influencer who personifies the ethos of Lazy Town, is determined to ruin the health and fitness practices of Stephanie and her friends. When the kids have difficulty with Robbie Rotten, Sportacus, a gymnast/athlete prepared to answer any call for help, comes to the rescue from his home in a zeppelin-like aircraft that hovers over earth. The underlying themes of Lazy Town stress the importance of eating "sports candy" (aka fruits and vegetables), always obtaining sufficient sleep, and going outside to engage in a wide range of physical activities including playing games, competing athletically, and even building forts and play structures.

Make Way for Noddy is based on a recurring character in the Enid Blyton book series for very young readers. Noddy, a boy doll, lives in a little cottage in the village of Toyland. He tools around in his sporty convertible, delivers the mail, and is a friend to all. Because he is very kind to others, he invariably is asked to help solve problems. But because he doesn't know everything, he also has a lot to learn. In each episode Noddy actively finds a way manage a project, soothe hurt feelings, settle arguments, or learn how to do something new by following directions. The examples in each episode are age appropriate challenges for children in the target audience and model clear and concrete solutions to problems.

2nd QUARTER 2014 EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

There is one new show for Q2 2014, Zou, which will replace Make Way for Noddy.

Zou is a French series based on the Zou books by Michel Gay. Targeted for children age 2-5, each episode explores the kind of learning issues that emerge from every day encounters in the life of a preschool child. If Zou plays his drums too loud, how can he learn to play them softly? If Zou wants a car, but has only a cardboard box, how can he transform it? If Zou lost his friend's favorite airplane, how does he explain? How can Zou be successful at baking a cake if he has never done it before? How can Zou muster the courage to go to the doctor when he's afraid of injections? These are big issues in the mind and life of a preschool child and Zou demonstrates how to have fun, ask for help, listen to advice, and try different solutions until he can commit to the strategy that works. The show says it, shows it, and does it, in the embedded and naturally occurring lesson within each episode.

1st QUARTER 2014 SHOW SUMMARIES

The Chica Show features a five-year-old "baby" chick who spends her days with her parents in their costume shop, the Coop. The shop's one employee, Kelly, doubles as Chica's nanny and the ensemble is rounded out with Bunji, a large floppy eared rabbit and Stitches, a straw mannequin that sits in the window. Chica's parents were formerly entertainers in the vaudeville tradition and they regale the audience with stories and songs from their theatrical past. They enjoy and indulge Chica, who sometimes acts younger than her age and gets into all kinds of predicaments. Kelly uses fantasy play to transform herself, Chica, Bunji and Stitches into animated characters in another universe, who are struggling with a problem similar to the one Chica experienced in the Coop. Without fail, they find the problem can be solved and they carry that knowledge back to the Coop to use on another day.

Noodle and Doodle is a live-action show hosted by Sean Roach that also blends animation and puppetry into the overall format. Sean drives a double-decker bus into various communities to meet children who have written to him with a problem that they would like to solve using an art and/or a food experience. Sean is accompanied by Noodle, a puppet character and Doodle, a digital character that lives inside a tablet computer, and Doggity, a faithful beagle. Doggity has a mini-show of his own through an animated alter ego that appears during diversionary segments set in a restaurant kitchen. The show demonstrates how recycled materials can become art and how food, art, and problem solving can be combined to create a fun experience in everyday life. Every episode can be replicated at home with ease by parents and children playing together.

Justin Time is an animated show specifically directed to the preschool audience and always conveys an embedded lesson; it is possible to understand and manage any problem you have by thinking about it creatively. Justin is a little boy who has two imaginary playmates, Olivia (who meets him on his travels) and Squidgy the sponge (who also lives in Justin's bedroom). When Justin has a problem or doesn't want to do something his mother has suggested he daydreams his way into an adventure that takes him to places all around the world. On these adventures, he meets Olivia who guides him through an experience that demonstrates to Justin how he can solve his problem. The show provides many facts about the context the characters visit while on the

adventure, but the central point is to teach a lesson about a social/emotional dilemma universally experienced by preschool children.

Tree Fu Tom focuses on the amazing adventures of a young boy called Tom who, with the power of 'movement magic' called 'Tree Fu', can transform into a tiny but mighty magical super hero and travel to a wondrous enchanted kingdom called Treetopolis that exists in a tree in his backyard woods. During each program he calls upon the audience to follow his moves to send him the "Big World" magic he needs to solve a problem encountered by Tom and his friends. . These include Ariella, a butterfly who is also a rancher and has rope lassoing skills; Twigs, an acorn sprite who folds himself into an acorn when he's frightened, Squirmturn, a pill bug who looks like a large and imposing coal miner but is often timid and fearful, and Zigzoo, a green tree frog and the resident genius inventor. In each episode there are an action adventure sequences that are key to resolving the challenge of the day.

Lazy Town is a show featuring the importance of health, fitness, and being good friends. Set in a fantasy world known as Lazy Town, which is populated by inactive residents, we meet a visitor named Stephanie who is determined to coax her friends and relatives into adopting a healthful, active life style. She wins over her new friends, Ziggy, Stingy, Trixie and Pixel, convincing them to leave their gaming consoles and candy stashes at home so they can go outside and play. She persuades her uncle, Mayor Milford Meanswell, and his friend Ms. Busy Body to support her efforts. Robbie Rotten, who lives underground, and is determined to return Lazy Town to its former state of inactivity and quiet, constantly foils the characters' efforts. Coming to the rescue is the athlete Sportacus who lives in a zeppelin-like aircraft and receives signals from the kids or the Mayor whenever they need help. Sportacus has two goals, to keep the peace and to promote healthful, positive living. When Robbie Rotten is discovered and contained through comic pratfalls, he returns to his underground lair and all is well in Lazy Town, until another day and another time when Robbie will rise again.

Make Way for Noddy is based on a recurring character in the Enid Blyton book series for very young readers. Noddy, a boy doll, lives in a little cottage in the village of Toyland. He tools around in his sporty convertible, delivers the mail, and is a friend to all. Noddy is surrounded by a large cast of other toy characters some of whom are mentors, and a few others who are mischief makers in Toyland. In every episode of Noddy, there is a challenge experienced by Noddy or someone else in Toyland that lends itself to a humorous and lighthearted resolution. Whether it's Martha the monkey getting her undoing for her selfish ways, Mr. Wobblyman learning to play soccer with no legs, or Noddy trying to assemble a kite, the characters in Toyland work out their issues and live together in harmony.

2nd QUARTER 2014 SHOW SUMMARIES

There is one new show for Q2 2014, Zou, which will replace Make Way for Noddy.

An animated series, Zou, is the story of a 5 year old zebra, Bizou, who lives in an intergenerational household composed of his parents, grandparents, and great grandmother. They reside in a lovely brightly colored suburban community of vertical, bi-pedaled zebras that walk, talk, dress and interact like humans. Bizou's best friend, Elzee lives next door and his other good friend, Zac, is often found in his father's store. Bizou also has a less rewarding relationship with his snooty, spoiled cousin Zinnia, a budding ballerina. We follow Zou through his hum-drum days, vicariously participating in his birthday, a trip to the store, taking his pet parakeet Poc, to the doctor, or helping Elzee find a lost toy. The show is very centered on family and personal relationships, and the abundant adults in the family are always around to guide but not direct Bizou through his dilemmas, projects, and predicaments.

THE CHICA SHOW

FARMER CHICA [ETCS113DH]

Something is shaking up the costume shop as though an earthquake is occurring. It turns out that the shaking is the crunch of Jet biting a carrot. He has food from the farmer's market to share but Chica has no time to eat fruits and vegetables. She wants to quickly eat a bag of chips and continue playing in her farmer costume. She tires early because she didn't eat properly and on the fantasy adventure, the problem repeats itself. Chica won't eat a good breakfast and gets so tired she can't even feed her horse. When they return home, Chica eats some healthful food so that she and Kelly have enough energy to walk home and make dinner with Mr. and Mrs. C.

[Educational Message: You have to eat healthful food like fruits and vegetables to have enough energy to do all the things you want to do every day.]

BOCK-A-DOODLE DOO, I LOVE YOU! [ETCS113DH]

Chica's parents are so nice and Chica wants to do something special to show how much she loves them. Chica and Kelly open a spa for Mrs. C and build a hammock for Mr. C. When an order comes in for a Yak costume, Chica assumes she can fill the order (so her parents can rest), but alas, while the costume is a Chica original, it is not a Yak. Chica feels she totally let her parents down and they won't love her anymore. On their fantasy adventure, Chica and Bunji are parents whose children, Kelly and Stiches accidentally toss Bunji's perfect carrot cake into the air. Even though the cake was ruined, parents Chica and Bunji, reassured their "son" he was still loved. Returning to the shop, Mr. C tells Chica her spa was such a big hit, he is now building her mother a new luxury bird bath. Chica realizes her parents still love her despite her mistake.

[Educational Message: Parents do expect their children to do their best, but even if they get upset if mistakes get made or accidents happen, the love will always be there.]

NOODLE AND DOODLE

A CHINESE NEW YEAR-DRAGONS [ENAD109DH]

Lucas, Isabel and Marcus want to make a dragon for their families to share on Chinese New Year. Sean and Noodle make Lucky Dragon Dumplings and recycle the egg carton for their craft later. The kids find chopsticks for the craft and they use them along with construction paper, paint and the egg cartons to make dancing dragons. Sean gives them the dumplings to take home with their dragons and Lucas, Isabel, and Marcus celebrate Chinese New Year with their family.

[Educational Message: During Chinese New Year, dragons are an important part of the decoration and celebration.]

WRAPPING PRESENTS-PAINTERS [ENAD109DH]

Cecilia is going to a birthday party for some twins and needs help finding a birthday gift for them. They like cooking with their dad so Sean suggests making them a jar of cookie mix to use for baking. Using a jar, they layer the dry baking ingredients, seal it and include a set of baking instructions. Sean and Noodle save the oatmeal box to create a gift box during the craft segment. Cecilia and her brother Julian make birthday cake gift boxes to store the cookie jar in and take it to the twins' birthday party.

[Educational Message: You can make very special gifts for your friends on their birthday.]

JUSTIN TIME

YODEL ODEL DAY [EJTM102DH]

Justin believes his scarf is babyish, and doesn't want to obey his mother to put it on for the snowy day. He enters his imagination to travel with Olive and Squidgy to visit Squidgy's grandpa for Yodel Odel Day and to take him a special gift. The scarf proves to be quite handy for the adventure of getting to Grandpa. Justin returns home to realize that even though he thought something wasn't needed, it came in very handy.

[Educational Message: The instructions our parents provide are to help us, and the things they suggest can prove handy.]

WAIT, LITTLE PENGUIN! [EJTM102DH]

Justin and Mom are going to go skating and Mom has to look for her skates. He enters his imagination where he, Olive, and Squidgy try to help a little penguin that is separated from its family. They think the penguin is playful or confused, instead of realizing that the penguin was really leading the way back to its family the entire time, and the kids were just not listening. When returning home, Justin realizes he should listen to his Mom while skating, because "if I would have listened the first time . . . I wouldn't have fallen."

[Educational Message: Listening is more than just hearing words, it's realizing the meaning behind the communication.]

TREE FU TOM

SQUIZZLE QUEST [ETFT101DH]

Twigs shows the friends how to play a game with his family's boomerang-like squizzle toy. The friends learn to play squizzle but Twigs isn't confident that he can make a difficult throw. Sure enough, they lose the toy deep in the slimy weeds where they are afraid to go because of the dreaded Rickety McGlum, a spider rumored to be very frightening. Tom draws upon his magical powers to advance the search. When they keep getting stuck in slime they realize they can use the goo to stop the quivering squizzle toy. They use the magic to grow the slime shooters and retrieve the Squizzle. Then the frightening Rickety approaches and the friends realize he is actually a very kind spider. They apologize for excluding him based on the scary rumors and all

work together to help Twigs believe he can make the difficult squizzle toss. He even uses it to save Zigzoo who has gotten trapped by a major slime shoot.

[Educational Message: Sometimes the things you are told are not true, like someone saying you can't do something because you are too small, or that something is terrible and scary. Give yourself and others a chance and you may be surprised with a good outcome.]

LAZY TOWN

ZAP IT [ELZT123DH]

Pixel creates a "Zapper" that makes anything disappear, and zaps Stephanie's messy room. When they tell Ziggy about the "zapper," Sportacus is skeptical and teaches them "when there is work to be done, there are no shortcuts." Robbie Rotten steals the "zapper" while the kids are engrossed in video games. Robbie disguises himself as a child in need of help and zaps Sportacus – but realizes that the zapper only makes things invisible. The kids realize this too, when they discover invisible, sticky messes. Stephanie feels bad that she should have just cleaned her room because her uncle gets injured in the invisible mess. Pixel vows to get the zapper back, and with the help of invisible Sportacus, he fights Robbie Rotten and retrieves it. They get to work rematerializing the invisible things in Lazy Town. Pixel and Stephanie apologize for being lazy and mean to each other, they agree that there are not any shortcuts for the work that needs to be done.

[Educational Message: When there is work to be done, like cleaning your room, there are not any shortcuts.]

MAKE WAY FOR NODDY

SHELF HELP [EMWN101DH]

Noddy wakes up ready to face the day all by himself. But when he can't open a jar he immediately drives over to Big Ears' house for help as though he had an emergency. He continues to interrupt Big Ears for every little thing until finally Big Ears puts on a disguise and tricks Noddy into learning how to help himself. Noddy later actually assembles his kite without any help from Big Ears.

[Educational Message: If you can think problems through by yourself, you will be able to do things on your own.]

NODDY'S SPECIAL TREAT [EMWN101DH]

Mr. Plod is naming a winner for a trip to the seaside. Little Skippy Skittle really wants to go because he missed the family vacation due to an ankle injury. Noddy wins the train trip and Martha Monkey tries to coerce Noddy into taking her. Then Mr. Jumbo pesters him too. But Big Ears advises him to think about who he would like to travel with, and Noddy's better judgment prevails. He takes Skippy Skittle to the shore for a holiday.

[Educational Message: Be a good judge of character and don't let others sway your feelings. Your true friends will be glad you've made the right decision.]

THE CHICA SHOW

VROOM, VROOM CHICA [ETCS112DH]

Chica is frustrated when she is "it" for a game of freeze tag because she is not fast enough to "tag" anyone and make them freeze. When the shop closes and she and Kelly go on their fantasy adventure, Chica, Kelly, Bunji, and Stitches are in an Indy 500 type race. Though she is in last place Chica perseveres and keeps going when her friends have to drop out of the race. She ultimately wins the race because she didn't give up when others had to quit. She tries her skill on Kelly when they return to the shop and she's able to catch Kelly at an opportune moment and tag for a "freeze."

[Educational Message: Sometimes a game is won based on perseverance, not by speed. Just take things at your own pace and eventually others will have to slow down or stop. Then you can move ahead and achieve your goals.]

CHICA, THE BOCK-A-DOODLE BUILDER [ETCS112DH]

Mrs. C is taking a customer on a tour of the shop, recounting her famous costumes. Chica enters in a self-made airplane and announces that she wants to build an airport inside the shop. Despite being told by Kelly that an airport is too big for the shop, Chica persists in trying to do something BIG. She doesn't accept the idea that "small is beautiful" too. While on their fantasy adventure Chica is the "boss" of a building company, and builds Bunji a HUGE house just to fix a broken roof shingle. Bunji finds the new house overwhelming. Chica has to tear it down and return to building something much smaller. Upon her return to the shop, Chica draws plan for new shingle for Bunji's cage.

[Educational Message: A large size isn't always the most important thing you can do to make an impression. Sometimes the small things are more appropriate and just as appreciated.]

NOODLE AND DOODLE

MEOW MEOW-ASTRONAUTS [ENAD113DH]

Samantha and her brother Joel just brought Charlie the cat home and want to make him feel welcome. Sean suggests making Charlie a toy and some kitty treats. On the bus, Noodle and Sean bake the treats using tuna and wheat germ. Sean, Samantha and Joel make toys for Charlie using tennis balls, socks, and some sticks to carry them. While Chica and her father go looking for a missing baby chick, they follow some clues—especially straw, but they could not find the baby chick. They are stumped and decide to continue looking tomorrow. On the fantasy adventure, Kelly loses her “diamond necklace” and enlists Detective Chica to assist her. When they go up to Bunji’s castle and find a few loose diamonds in the main room they assume Bunji and Stitch are the thieves. A chase ensues and they end up in a closet where Stitch, the butler, found the necklace on the floor and used it as a chain for a light switch. Kelly and Chica realize they assumed the necklace was stolen when actually Kelly lost it and Stitch picked it up and used it as something else. They needed to look at the problem differently. When they return to the coop they realize that the straw clue was actually just the stuffing from the delivery box. They open the box and find the baby chick sitting at the bottom with more of the straw.

[Educational Message: When you run out of clues while looking for something, try to think of another direction the clues might point to for finding your lost item.]

The kids use the recycled materials to make the mermaid tails. They take the tails to act out their adventure and enjoy the special treat.

[Educational Message: You can creatively design projects, like mermaid tails, using materials found in your home to act out your story time.]

adventure Kelly and Chica visit with Bunji who can work magic spells and wakes everyone up from their sleep. He calls on them to stay awake and play but he can't even conjure up a spell that will make the beds go away. When he finally makes the beds disappear, Chica does a spell and the beds return to the room. Everyone goes to sleep as Bunji says: "Tonight our magic was not our best, because we really needed some rest."

[Educational Message: Everyone needs an adequate amount of sleep every night. Sleep recharges our batteries so we can be our best performer the very next day.]

Later Mrs. C chastises Chica because her attention seeking behavior was getting in Ms. Velson's way. In the fantasy adventure, Chica plays a very famous golfer who is interrupted by an avid fan. Finally when it's time for Chica to try her final shot, she tells the fan, that she needs quiet in order to succeed with this critical shot. The fan agrees and Chica hits a winning shot in the golf game.

[Educational Message: It is important not to interrupt another person so they can concentrate and their work can be completed.]

He disguises himself as Dr. Rottenstein and creates a new disease – spotty vegetitis – to trick everyone into not eating vegetables, not getting fresh air, and staying inside and eating junk food – all while banning Sportacus from Lazy Town. Sportacus sends the kids notes, and Robbie Rotten breaks into Sportacus' aircraft to try and prevent Sportacus from sharing his healthy habits. Ziggy has to revive everyone with carrots in order to help save Sportacus and his aircraft/home. Ultimately Robbie Rotten is exposed as the conniving doctor and Ziggy develops a love for vegetables that gives him the strength and energy to help out and make a difference.

[Educational Message: Candy doesn't really give you energy, but vegetables give you energy that lasts.]

Before he can go home to eat his own lunch, the goblins bribe him for another ride to the train station, and then to the countryside where the Bouncing Balls attack Noddy's car. The torment continues because Noddy runs out of gas and has to walk to town to get gasoline and food. Big Ears sees Noddy and informs him that the goblins were being selfish and mean, even though they said "please" when they asked for a free ride. Noddy tells them a very firm "NO" the next time he is approached for a free ride.

[Educational Message: You can stand up to people who are being demanding and selfish by saying "NO."]

NODDY ON THE MOVE [EMWN109DH]

Noddy considers moving as Master Tubby Bear suggests he might be happier near the center of town where all the excitement is. Noddy tows the house to a new location where he thinks he will be happier. Noddy moves next door to Tessie and her chickens come inside looking for corn. Noddy tows the house to another location next to Mr. Sparks. The noise from the shop is maddening. He then moves to the Town Square where he can see his friends right outside his

window. Noddy finds this won't work either and finally heads back to his own space in the "suburbs" of Toy Town, convinced this location is really the best place for him to live.

[Educational Message: Sometimes leaving your home can help you realize how much you have to be thankful for.]

On their fantasy adventure, Kelly and Chica go to a wooded area, where everyone is dressed in a bug costume. Each of the group shows his or her talent as that particular bug. Stitch is an ant, Kelly is a lightning bug, Chica is a spider and Bunji is a honeybee. Chica doesn't think spiders have any function that is valuable, but they tell her that spiders eat mosquitoes, which is VERY important. When they return to the shop, Chica decides to call bugs "cool crawlies." Kelly explains that Chica doesn't have to play with the spiders and bugs, but she should leave them alone to do their work.

[Educational Message: Many bugs, worms, and spiders do very important work for our gardens and help plants and animals grow.]

CHICA'S PARADE [ETCS207DH]

Several people are in the shop preparing for a Spring Time Surprise Parade. Kelly is making a float. Chica tells Kelly it won't take her anytime to make a float. She decides she wants to have a float made right before the parade begins. Mrs. C Does Bunji Float, Mr. C does a Bee hive, Kelly does a floral float and Chica comes out hauling a cardboard box. Kelly finds out that Chica really is embarrassed about her float, so on their fantasy adventure, they discover after two failed efforts, that they will follow Chica's plan and her assignments to each person. The final product is strong and beautiful.

[Educational Message: When you have a project like building something you have to have a plan and follow that plan. The plan can be organized in steps and each person working on the project can be responsible for specific work.]

DOWN ON THE FARM-FAMILY ON VACATION [ENAD103DH]

Sean and Noodle make the smoothies. In Doggity's segment the crew makes healthy traveling snack boxes to have for a lunch on the go. The kids come and use the leftover milk to make magic-milk using food coloring and soap, and then capture the reaction on paper. The kids share the smoothies with their family and show their aunt and uncle how to make the magic-milk pictures.

[Educational Message: You can make a healthy smoothie and magic-milk pictures using milk].

SWEET MEMORIES-SWIMMERS [ENAD103DH]

Samantha and Jessica want to help make their grandparents' wedding anniversary special. They brainstorm ways to make a sweet memories cake using tropical fruit to remind them of their honeymoon in Hawaii and cake-toppers using old pictures. They recycle the oil-bottle lid for the cake-toppers. In Doggity's segment the crew makes hearty stuffed pasta for hard-working construction workers. The kids bring their photos to make the cake toppers. They take the cake home to surprise their grandparents and celebrate their anniversary with them.

[Educational Message: You can make a cake to celebrate a special moment for someone you love and make a topper to make it extra personalized and special.]

The shortcuts all fail, and Justin realizes that "if I had followed the instructions, we would be done by now." They work together and follow the directions so they are able to enjoy the beautiful constellations. Justin returns home where he and Dad follow the directions to complete the new play set.

[Educational Message: Following directions is important and will lead to the desired outcome.]

[Educational Message: Many times it is important to make a good plan, and sometimes you need to do things as you go. You should learn from balancing different approaches in order to handle problems effectively.]

Ziggy has completed training and tries to help again, but doesn’t follow the “start small” advice and continues to make mistakes. While Robbie Rotten is sawing through the branch, he gets stuck. Sportacus saves him, and then Ziggy prevents Robbie Rotten from getting smashed by the branch. He realizes anyone can be a hero if you start small and take it step-by-step.

[Educational Message: Your friends like you for who you are, not because you have “super” powers. So if you want to excel, start small and continue practicing to become really good at something.]

When Tessie Bear spills lemonade on her dress, Master Tubby Bear calls her “messy” bear. When Noddy tells him it is mean to call names, Master Tubby calls him “nutty” rather than Noddy. When Big Ears eats his sundae in one slurp, Teddy calls him “big mouth”. Teddy then moves on to call Mr. Wobblyman, “wishy-washy” because he is indecisive. A visit to Mr. Sparks results in him being called Mr. Honks, Clown gets called Frown, and Jumbo becomes “jump-back.” But when the Skittles called him “stubby” bear when he is stubs his toe, he realizes that the words he

used to describe his friends probably hurt their feelings. Master Tubby Bear arranges to apologize to everyone at the ice cream shop.

[Educational Message: Name calling can be very hurtful, perhaps more hurtful than hitting someone.]

Mr. and Mrs. C stress that Chica needs to finish all the chores on her checklist which makes Chica a bit unhappy. While on their fantasy adventure Kelly and Chica are out with Stiches and Bunji on a submarine. Chica announces that they are supposed to find a giant undersea squid, but the hatch must be fixed and the propeller attached before they can explore. Bunji and Stitch play instead of doing their chores, so the sub takes on water and has no propulsion as they make a descent to the deep. They have to divert a disaster and finish those chores. Afterwards, they manage to find a giant squid before they return home.

[Educational Message: Always complete your work before taking time to play. That way, the things you need to do your work or just have fun will be working properly and where they belong when you go looking for them.]

TIPPY TOP CHICA [ETCS208DH]

Chica feels bad because she is small. She is too short to reach up high to get her father's wig. She tries on a pair of really long wings to reach long distances, but she and her father knock over things with the fake wings. Chica's father tells her they will both have to get help to reach things that are way up high or too far out of reach. On their fantasy adventure, Kelly formulates a potion that makes all four of the group grow really tall. Stiches and Kelly don't like being really big. So Chica tries another potion and it makes them really small. Chica suggests blending the two liquids will make each of them just the right size for who they are. Back at the store Kelly couldn't reach over the counter, but Chica could walk right under the ledge to pick up a missing object. Chica was just the right size after all.

[Educational Message: We cannot control how big or small we are, but we can find an advantage to being any size or any height. That will help us be happy about who we are.]

Meanwhile, the kids collect sticks and leaves and join Sean to make kites using the recycled products, items from nature, and contact paper. [Educational Message: When it is windy outside, you can find objects outside and in your recycling bin to make kites.]

ART-TASTIC-PAINTERS [ENAD101DH]

Avery, Ian, and Elena want to color but only have little pieces of crayons left. They begin by brainstorming ways to repurpose and use the old crayons. Sean and Noodle then melt the old crayon pieces into new multi-colored crayons in the kitchen. They also recycle the lids of the non-stick spray to make a leaf wreath, using the new crayons for leaf rubbings. The kids hang up the wreath and take the new crayons to finish their artwork.

[Educational Message: You can reuse your old broken crayons to make new ones in order to recycle and prevent waste.]

[Educational Message: Be honest about your fears, and be willing to overcome them.]

CLEOPATRA'S CAT [EJTM112DH]

Mom is looking for her phone and Justin doesn't admit that he was playing with it. He and Squidgy enter the imaginary world of Ancient Egypt where Olive is a cat groomer for the beautiful Cleopatra. Justin and Squidgy try to give the cat a bath and it runs away. They admit to Olive that they lost the cat and try to use the clues to find it. When they meet Cleopatra, they tell her the truth about the lost cat, and she isn't mad, she just calls for the cat and tells them she appreciates their honesty. When Justin returns home, he tells Mom about playing with the phone, and they find it together.

[Educational Message: Be honest about situations you have created so that others can help you.]

He'll make it to the train station on time.

[Educational Message: It is important to be on time; and if unexpected frustrations come up don't give up, just calmly find a solution.]

Kelly takes a sip to be courteous and as she savors it, declares that she LOVES IT. Chica wins the competition.

CHICA'S SENSE-SATIONAL DAY [ETSC209DH]

The group is playing a game in the coop where a blindfolded participant listens carefully to find out where each player is standing. Shortly after the game is over a new customer, Jimmy, who is blind, comes into the store. Though he cannot see, Jimmy uses all his other senses--smell, hearing, taste, and touch to figure out what's in his environment. Using his sense of touch, Jimmy selects a captain's hat for his costume. Kelly and Mr. and Mrs. C blindfold Chica so she can use all her senses to discover where they are in the coop. Chica was not successful in locating anyone with her first try, so when she and Kelly go on their fantasy adventure, they are on a sailboat where they use their senses to identify the smell of fish, the warmth of the sun, the wind in their hair, the sound of the foghorn which guides them back to shore.

[Educational Message: Our five senses are very important to us and if we lost one, such as sight, our other senses can be developed to help guide us through the world.]



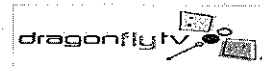
