The local low-frequency radio station KRBS 107.1 is going to start broadcasting at full-power on Monday, but they hope to have high-frequency waves flowing in time to broadcast at the parade tonight at 6 p.m.

The local radio station embarked on the path to getting a high-frequency call sign more than a year ago.

Ron Ullman, board director for the station, said they found out the license VILL Beissued on Tuesday. 12-11-12

With the radio tower and antenna in Forbestown, the station will reach into

four counties.

"We will have 10 times as much power as we did before," Ullman said.

The station will now broadcast at least 50 miles.


people. The website www.oroville radio.org lists the programs. The station also welcomes new programs.


