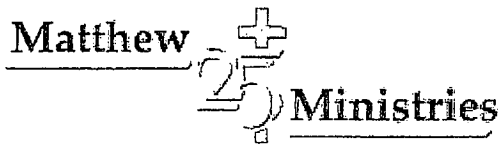

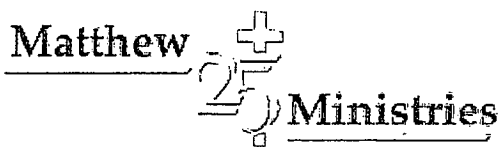

These donated products are processed at our 132,000 square-foot processing center ir and then shipped via forty-foot seagoing containers and by semi-trailers to the poor thr United States and around the world.

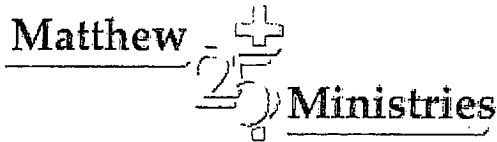

DISASTER RESPONSE

In disaster situations, time is a precious commodity and implementing an effective disaster response is critical. Matthew 25: Ministries is constantly monitoring its readiness to meet the needs of a sudden disaster. This includes maintaining the facilities and resources needed, as well as being ready to engage disaster relief volunteers from the local community who want to provide relief to the victims.

DISASTER SUPPORT PROCESS

In order to provide the most effective disaster support possible, supplies must be sorted and ready to be shipped. When aid products reach the devastated area, they need to be ready for distribution. Matthew 25: Ministries ships only pre-sorted, pre-processed items that are appropriate and seasonally appropriate to the disaster area. This ensures that the products will bring relief to the victims instead of creating additional work for the responders in the area. According to the United Nations Disaster Relief Organization, "The impulsive generosity of government organizations, and individuals alike can cause as much chaos and confusion as the disaster itself."

NATURAL DISASTER RELIEF

Matthew 25: Ministries has responded to a wide variety of natural disasters including cyclones, tsunamis, earthquakes, floods, hurricanes, windstorms, and droughts. Most recently, Matthew 25: Ministries has been shipping disaster relief products to Japan in response to the March earthquake, tsunami, and nuclear crisis.

HURRICANE RELIEF

- 2008 - Matthew 25 responded to Hurricane Ike by sending aid to Haiti and Texas and a mission team to Texas.
- 2008 - Matthew 25 responded to Hurricane Gustav.
- 2005 - Matthew 25 provided disaster support for Hurricane Katrina.
- 1998 - Hurricane Mitch was our first large-scale attempt at disaster relief. Within a few days we were able to have relief supplies on the ground both in Nicaragua and Honduras where relief efforts were well-established in these countries.

TSUNAMI RELIEF

- 2004 - Matthew 25 responded to the Indian Ocean tsunami disaster.

EARTHQUAKE RELIEF

- 2010 - Matthew 25 sent disaster relief and medical mission teams to Haiti in response to an earthquake.
- 2005 - Matthew 25 provided disaster response to the Pakistan earthquake.

FLOODING RELIEF

- 2009 - Matthew 25 responded to flash flooding in Louisville.
- 2009 - Matthew 25 responded to flooding in Eastern Kentucky.
- 2008 - Matthew 25 shipped relief to Iowa after severe flooding.

OTHER DISASTER RELIEF

- 2011 - Matthew 25 sent meals from our Prasco Food Processing Center, water and supplies to the earthquake and tsunami disaster victims in Japan.
- 2008 - Matthew 25 delivers ice and water to Greater Cincinnati after a severe winter storm caused by Hurricane Ike.
- 2008 - Matthew 25 sent aid to Myanmar after Cyclone Nargis.
- 2008 - Matthew 25 responded to Tropical Storm Alma.
