Issue: Homelessness and Hunger in mid-Delmarva (12/21/22 at 5:30 a.m. Duration: 7 minutes)

Program: “Bridging the Gap”, public affairs program. Interview with Katherine Albon and Kaila Miller – Love, INC of Mid-Delmarva.

Host Bill Sammons asked guests to describe the services offered by Love, INC., and specifically to discuss the homelessness situation in the region, and what Love, INC is doing to help. The organization has started a daily feeding program, currently serving approximately 40 people. The prepared meals are distributed daily between 6 and 7 pm and the organization needs volunteers to help serve. They also coordinate Code Purple services for the region, and discuss the need for volunteers to help staff the shelters overnight during the winter months. Additionally, clips from the interview were aired on The Morning Show with Bill & Denise on Wednesday morning, December 21, 2022.

Issue: Human Trafficking and Child Sex Abuse (11/30/22 at 5:30 a.m. Duration: 9 minutes)

Program: “Bridging the Gap, public affairs program. Interview with Daniel Rojas, founder and president of Thrive Vision.

Host Bill Sammons interviewed Daniel Rojas about the issue of Human Trafficking and specifically child sex abuse and human organ harvesting. Rojas works in Costa Rica and is in the United States to raise awareness and funds for his organization as they rescue children from trafficking and provide housing, education, medical services, etc to children on a long term basis. Additionally clips were aired on The Morning Show with Bill & Denise on November 30, 2022.

Issue: Grief and Loss

Hosts Bill Sammons and Denise Harper interviewed Davey Blackburn of Nothing Is Wasted Ministries. Pastor Davey’s young pregnant wife was murdered during a home invasion. Davey told his story and discussed the process of grieving, faith, forgiveness, healing, hope, and turning pain into purpose. Listeners called in and texted the studio with questions.

Program: Interview with Roger Wood, Ex Dir God's Way To Recovery
Host Bill Sammons and Executive Director of God's Way To Recovery discuss covering the costs of 2 tractor trailer loads of new mattresses (twin, double, & queen sized) for the recovery process going on in South FL after the hurricane devastation. Listeners were invited to give toward the purchase of mattress sets. Transportation costs are being covered.
