

## **WJMA 3rd Quarter 2022 Issues and Programs**

We continued on air recruitment on WJMA to our listeners advising of our commitment to provide public service announcements and the promotion of non-profit, charitable and governmental organizations.

WJMA produced and aired public service announcements for organizations in the Central Virginia area including but not limited to the following:

“Local Issues Real People” Sunday mornings at 8am. The program features local leaders, various clubs and organizations and community members discussing a variety topics that are current and relevant to the Central Virginia area. Summer Lunch Program - Promotion of free breakfast and lunch for Culpeper County students during the Summer months. Meals were made available Monday through Friday at two locations in the town of Culpeper.

Orange Office On Youth/Orange Parks and Recreation – The grand opening of Unionville Community Park was held in conjunction with a school supply fundraiser July 9<sup>th</sup> for Orange County School Students.

Circle of Love Foundation – The COLF conducted its “Backpacks for Success” fundraiser for Louisa County School students. The goal was to fill 100 backpacks for students in Louisa County. Monetary donations could be made to the COLF to achieve the goal.

Pack The Patrol Car – The Culpeper Town Police Department conducted its annual fundraiser for school supplies for students in Culpeper County. The event was held August 5<sup>th</sup> at multiple locations in Culpeper.

Home Delivered Meals - Meals were made available to residents over 60 in Culpeper, Fauquier, Madison, Orange and Rappahannock Counties by the Rappahannock-Rapidan Community Services Board and the Area Agency on Aging. Five frozen meals were delivered weekly to area seniors.

Foster Care Packages - The Orange Treasurer’s Office collected items to create care packages for children entering foster care during the month of September. Listeners were encouraged to donate.

WJMA continued with local EAS participation providing information for severe weather alerts, Amber Alerts, Virginia State Tornado Drill and North Anna Nuclear Power Station drills.
