FOUR WICHITA SCHOOLS ARE BACK OPEN AFTER BEING ON LOCK DOWN FOLLOWING A SHOOTING IN WEST WICHITA...POLICE SAY THAT A 22-YEAR-OLD MAN IS IN CRITICAL CONDITION AFTER BEING SHOT IN THE HEAD. THEY SAY THREE SUSPECTS ENTERED THE VICTIMS HOUSE AT THE 16-HUNDRED BLOCK OF WEST MAPLE AND SHOT HIM... THEY SAY A SMALL CHILD WAS IN THE HOUSE AT THE TIME OF THE SHOOTING BUT WASN'T HURT...FOUR SCHOOLS IN THE AREA WENT ON LOCK DOWN AROUND 9am AND WERE RE-OPENED A HOUR LATER...POLICE SAY THE VICTIM MAY HAVE BEEN TARGETED...NO ARRESTS HAVE BEEN MADE

ONE MAN IS DEAD AND ANOTHER WOUNDED AFTER A SHOOTING IN VALLEY CENTER. INVESTIGATORS SAY IT HAPPENED JUST BEFORE THREE SUNDAY MORNING... AS OFFICERS WERE CALLED OUT TO A REPORT OF A SHOOTING IN THE 83-HUNDRED BLOCK OF NORTH 94TH STREET – WEST WHEN DEPUTIES ARRIVED THEY FOUND A TWO VICTIMS, BOTH IN THEIR EARLY TWENTIES, SUFFERING FROM GUNSHOT WOUNDS. BOTH WERE TAKEN TO THE HOSPITAL WHERE ONE DIED AN HOUR LATER... OFFICIALS SAY ONE PERSON **IS IN CUSTODY. NO WORD YET ON A POSSIBLE MOTIVE.

CRAIG, WE KNOW WHEN OFFICERS ARRIVED ON THE SCENE OF THE CALL, THEY FOUND A WOMAN INSIDE A HOME AT THE LAMPLIGHTER MOBILE HOME PARK, AND SHE SAID A SUSPECT WAS ARMED WITH A GUN AND THREATENED TO KILL HER. OFFICERS SAY THEY SET UP A PERIMETER AROUND the HOME AND TRIED TO TALK TO THE SUSPECT. THEY SAY THE MAN DID NOT LISTEN TO OFFICERS, AND THEY SAY THE SUSPECT WALKED INTO THE HOUSE. THEN, POLICE RELEASED A K-9 OFFICER... THE K-9 OFFICER WAS NAMED ROOSTER... AND POLICE ON THE SCENE SAY ROOSTER GOT AHOLD OF THE SUSPECTS LEG. BUT... OFFICERS SAY THAT SUSPECT REACHED FOR A GUN IN HIS WAISTBAND, AND THAT'S WHEN OFFICERS OPENED FIRE. THE SUSPECT WAS LATER PRONOUNCED DEAD. AND THE K-9 OFFICER, ROOSTER, ALSO WAS SHOT DURING THE ALTERCATION. TODAY, THE SUSPECT'S NEXT DOOR NEIGHBOR SPOKE TO US -- SAYING HE HEARD THE GUNSHOTS, BUT DIDN'T THINK ANYONE LIVED NEXT DOOR.

KATIE, MARK... KSN SPOKE WITH SOME FORMER COOPER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS WHO SAY THEY'RE *SAD ABOUT THE SCHOOL'S POSSIBLE CLOSURE. BUT SEDGWICK COUNTY COMMISSIONER JIM HOWELL SAYS HIS *CONCERN... COMES DOWN TO SAFETY. HOWELL WAS *ALSO AT LAST NIGHT'S USD 260 BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING WHERE HE SHARED HIS THOUGHTS IN THE PROPOSAL. SHOULD COOPER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CLOSE DOWN, THE DISTRICT WOULD EXPAND *OAKLAWN ELEMENTARY* INTO *FOUR SECTIONS. THE PROBLEM... HOWELL SAYS... A STATE SENATE COMMITTEE IS RECOMMENDING MORE CUTS TO SCHOOL FUNDING AS THE STATE TRIES TO FIX A BILLION-DOLLAR SHORTFALL. THE BILL ADVANCED BY THE SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE IS CALLING FOR A 5-PERCENT CUT -- OR 128-MILLION-DOLLARS -- TO GENERAL STATE AID IN THIS YEAR'S BLOCK GRANTS. THAT WOULD MEAN U-S-D 259 WOULD LOSE 14-POINT-1 MILLION DOLLARS. THE COMMITTEE IS CALLING FOR A 3-PERCENT DECREASE IN HIGHER EDUCATION FUNDING. MEMBERS SAY THESE NUMBERS ARE A "STARTING POINT" AND THE LEVEL OF CUTS ARE LIKELY TO BE ADJUSTED.

SEDGWICK COUNTY SHERIFF JEFF EASTER SPOKE ON IMPENDING CHANGES TO HOW THEY DEAL WITH ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS AND THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AT A PRESS CONFERENCE YESTERDAY. UNDER THE OLD POLICY, THE JAIL WOULD NOT ACCEPT THOSE ARRESTED FOR BEING UNDOCUMENTED AND, IMMIGRATION CONTROL AND ENFORCEMENT WOULD NOT SUPPLY AN AFFIDAVIT, SOMETHING THE SHERIFF SAYS IS DONE BY OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES. UNDER THE NEW POLICY, THE GOVERNMENT WILL SUPPLY PAPERWORK TO HOLD UNDOCUMENTED INDIVIDUALS. THE JAIL WILL THEN HOLD THE SUSPECTS FOR 48-HOURS, WHETHER OR NOT THEY'RE UNDOCUMENTED.
