These PSAs, which generally air for 30 seconds, addressed a variety of issues from a number of organizations. Examples of PSAs aired during the Reporting Period include:

Issue	Broadcast Times	Brief Description
Health	Jan/Feb	More than 1 in 3 Americans has prediabetes, putting them at risk of developing type 2 diabetes, heart attack, or stroke. 81 percent don't know they have it. By making lifestyle changes like managing weight, eating healthier, and increasing activity, prediabetes can often be reversed.
Education	Jan/Feb	More than 29 million adults across the U.S. don't have a high school diploma or equivalent. Viewers are directed to FinishYourDiploma.org, where they can access free adult education centers and learn more about the steps it takes to go back to school and finish their high school diploma.
