It has provided him an outlet to stay busy and have that purpose he was missing since he left the service.</p> <p>Mr Willis is an Army Veteran who served from 1989-1998 as a CavScout, 19D. He served in Desert Storm in 1991 with A Troop 1-7 Cav out of Fort Hood, TX. He sustained back injury in a bradley accident, was told he was never going to walk again. But within a few weeks he was up and walking and back on the battlefield, in time for the ground war to start.</p> <p>Today Mr Willis is joined by fellow friends and veterans to produce hand made walking canes and walking sticks to give back to the veterans and civilian community for free. Each and every piece they create comes from the heart and made with pride to know that something so simple can mean so much.</p>

10/21/2020	TxDOT launches new pedestrian and bicyclist safety campaign	<p>Fatalities from crashes involving pedestrians are on the rise in Texas and now account for nearly one in five of all of the state's traffic deaths. Last year, 668 people died in pedestrian-related crashes in Texas, up by 5% from 2018, and more than 1,300 were seriously injured. Crashes involving bicyclists in 2019 also claimed the lives of 68 people and seriously injured 313. These numbers follow an alarming trend that has seen pedestrian and bicyclist fatalities increase over the last five years.</p> <p>Safety officials attribute a primary cause of the increase to people's widespread failure to follow state laws designed to protect pedestrians and bicyclists. To that end, TxDOT is kicking off a new public awareness campaign this month that urges all Texans to drive smart, walk smart and bike smart.</p>

Joseph Michael Hamilton admits and agrees that on or about June 11, 2020, Hamilton did steal, take, and attempt to take from and out of a letter box, mail receptacle, or authorized depository for mail located at the United States Post Office in Slaton Texas.
