KCBD COMMUNITY EVENTS

January 11, 2024

KCBD's News Director delivered a program on creative storytelling to the local chapter of the Association of Fundraising Professionals and provided lessons on effectively communicating. Using an example of a story by KCBD's evening news anchor showcasing creative and interesting reporting. Association members were encouraged to share story ideas to boost coverage of our community. The AFP is a member-based group that empowers individuals and organizations to practice ethical fundraising through professional education, networking research and advocacy.

January 24, 2024

KCBD's News Director provided a weather presentation to Plains Cotton Growers. PCG was organized in 1956 by cotton producers from across the High Plains production region. They are a nonprofit certified producer organization composed of cotton producers from the Texas High Plains serving 42 counties that promote and protect the interests of cotton producers. The News Director reviewed last year's deadly tornado in Matador, Texas then provided a long-term weather outlook. The weather is critical to our agriculture, which is a primary industry in the Lubbock area.

February 17, 2024

Several members of the KCBD news team volunteered for the annual Lubbock Lions Club Pancake Festival at the Civic Center. This is one of the largest events of its kind in the country. The money raised goes to support over 30 charities in the South Plains area like Children's Miricle Network, Meals on Wheels, The Salvation Army, Adult Eyeglass Program, LISD Eyeglasses for Children, Texas Lions Camp for children with special needs to name a few.

February 17, 2024

KCBD's News Director served as emcee for the Southwest Parkinson Society 2024 Chocolate Fantasia at the Frazier Alumni Pavilion on the Texas Tech campus. This annual fundraiser helps the organization provide services and support to individuals impacted with Parkinson's Disease. KCBD's Sports Director served as one of the judges, with categories for both student and professional chefs providing creative chocolate sculptures.

February 22, 2024

KCBD's News Director provided a station tour to the local chapter of P.E.O. International, (Philanthropic Educational Organization) a women's empowerment group that celebrates the advancement of women. The organization educates women through scholarships, grants, awards, and loans to motivate each other to achieve their highest aspirations. The local group learned about the station's operations, how we connect to charitable and civic groups, and how we serve the community. The group was also able to observe the beginning of our KCBD 11 @ Noon newscast.

March 5, 2024

KCBD's News Director served as emcee for the Lubbock Boys & Girls Club 28th Annual Outback Charity Event. This is a major fundraiser for the Boys & Girls Club, with more than \$60,000 raised from the live auction and donation plea alone. Texas Tech University and Pro Football Hall-of-Famer Zach Thomas was the guest speaker. The organization nurtures young people's self-esteem by instilling in them a sense of belonging, usefulness, influence, and competence. Clubs do this daily by providing young people with one-on-one relationships with caring adult professionals and fun, age-appropriate, well-rounded programming. The boys and girls receive help with their homework each day and are provided with a nutritional meal after school. The Lubbock Boys & Girls Club serves the South Plains area with five clubs.

March 12, 2024

KCBD's Investigative Reporter spoke to the local chapter of the Association for Women in Communication. Participating as part of a panel on Freedom of Information, the presentation gave insight to members about investigative journalism and how it serves our community. AWC powers through professional development and networking for members to enhance the lives of local communications students through scholarships.

March 20, 2024


Various KCBD news department employees volunteered as servers for the day for the 35th annual Mayors' Beans & Cornbread Luncheon, benefiting Hospice of Lubbock. The funds raised provide free hospice care to the unfunded and underfunded across 19 counties in our region.

March 23, 2024

KCBD, in partnership with the Science Spectrum, the Student Chapter of the American Meteorological Society at Texas Tech University and the National Weather Service hosted Lubbock's annual Severe Weather Awareness Day on Saturday, March 23, 2004.

This free event is educational for children and provides the public with steps to take to be ready for severe weather. Activities included hands-on weather experiments for kids of all ages, live weather science demonstrations with

electricity and lightning simulators, information on severe weather preparedness, and door prizes. Storm Chasing and Emergency response vehicles, as well as weather instrumentation from Texas Tech's Severe Storm Research Team were also on-site. Various meteorological KCBD staff were present for this public education event.
