WAFN-FM’s Friday Morning “Live” Coaches Breakfast Football Show, from 6AM until 9AM each Friday Morning in the month of October also contributed a 10 minutes segment each week to report on area events and fund raisers.

During the month of December 2016 (December 1 – 22<sup>nd</sup>), WAFN-FM presented the “Forgotten Friends Christmas” with listeners donating over 3500 pounds of dog and cat food for distribution to area animal welfare shelters. On December 22<sup>nd</sup>, Fun Radio distributed all food to five area animal shelters. In addition, WAFN-FM spearheaded a drive to raise \$500 to donate to the “Forgotten Felines” rescue center to help pay for inoculation and feeding of over 200 kittens rescued from a “kitten mill” in the WAFN-FM listening area. Note that Marshall County, home county for WAFN-FM is the largest county in the State of Alabama without an animal welfare agency or shelter.

In addition, WAFN-FM aired over 500 live Public Service Announcements each month October through December 2016 for various groups and organizations in fund raising and event announcements.
