

Located on 100 acres in the foothills on the eastern edge of campus, Red Butte Garden offers year-round colorful displays, hiking trails, and panoramic views.

With more than 21 acres of developed gardens and five miles of trails winding through an extensive Natural Area, Red Butte Garden is the perfect place to connect with nature in the city. The Garden, which is community-funded, is renowned for its numerous plant collections, display gardens, 560,000 springtime blooming bulbs, including a vast collection of daffodils; gorgeous private event spaces; award-winning, horticulture-based educational programs; and a world-class outdoor concert series.

Enjoy time with family and friends, get ideas for your own garden, and experience the physical and mental health benefits of time spent in nature. Grow your mind with botanically inspired workshops and classes on gardening, cooking, and outdoor health and wellness.

Red Butte Garden is open year-round to the public. Entrance fees are \$7 for children age 3-17, \$12 for seniors and military personnel with ID, and \$14 for adults. The garden is located at 300 Wakara Way in Salt Lake City. It is open from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. (with the exception of concert days, when the garden closes at 5 p.m.) through the end of August.
