[VO] Firefighters and first responders put their lives on the line every time they're called into action. Each year, thousands are injured and scores die during emergency response, and in training exercises. A new study to understand why has just been released. Funded by the Office of Domestic Preparedness and the University of Maryland, the study looks at what happens to a firefighter's life signs during extreme training, to see if deaths and injuries can be reduced and prevented.

[rep. - Maryland Fire and Rescue Institute] There's about a hundred and ten firefighter fatalities each year. There's over ninety thousand injuries to firefighters that require some sort of medical treatment. So, it's very dangerous work that they're engaged in. Unfortunately, about ten percent of the fire fatalities occur during fire and rescue training.

[rep. - Fairfield Fire Dept.] During an incident, you're your own worst judge of your situation. Your adrenaline is going so much, you may not even notice that you're at that point that you're about to collapse.

[rep. - College Park Volunteer Fire Dept.] My biggest job is to make sure my people go home. A man going down, especially if he's entrapped, is a major issue. For one down, you'll lose three.

[VO] Until now, there was no way to measure a first responder's life signs during training and during an emergency response.

[?] This grant is allowing us to gather high resolution data on fire fighters, and use that data to create guidelines that will improve firefighter safety.

[VO] Over two hundred fire fighters participated in this study at the Maryland Fire and Rescue Institute. Each fire fighter in the study was put through maze crawls, hose drags, one thousand-degree training fires, and other standard training exercises for eight hours, while having their vital signs monitored continuously by wearing Vivometrics Lifeshirt.

[rep. - College Park Volunteer Fire Dept.] The advantages of the Lifeshirt, as we see now, we are able to use that technology in live fire situations. So we are getting live data extremely important.

[VO] The data collected from this study will be used to improve training practices across the country. It is hoped that this will lead to fewer deaths and injuries during fire and rescue training in the coming years.
