The Coastal Regional Commission – Area Agency on Aging (AAA) held its annual holiday food drive once again this year. Each year, the AAA seeks to provide groceries to vulnerable seniors with limited means during the holiday season. The AAA coordinates services, such as the meals on wheels program, across a nine county region. Many seniors call our office desiring to be placed on the roll to receive meals on wheels. Unfortunately, due to limited funding, many of those seniors are placed on a waiting list. And in some cases can remain on the waiting list for months or a year before a slot becomes available. For this reason, the AAA coordinates the food drive to help those that remain on the waitlist. In the past, we have served seniors in Glynn and McIntosh counties. This year's focus was to serve seniors on the waiting list for home delivered meals in Glynn. Approximately 60 seniors are still on the waiting list. Fortunately, there aren't any seniors on the waiting list in McIntosh County this year.

This year, through a partnership with Goodwill, several new partners were added to assist with this effort. We appreciate the donation of goods and items valued at over \$500 that were given to our seniors in need. Not to mention the invaluable airtime and broadcast announcements to the public. Through your generosity, and the generosity of others, we were able to serve not only the 60 seniors on the waitlist, but served an additional 40 seniors in the community who needed help this holiday season.

We are so excited to have IHEART Radio partner with us to share some love to our most vulnerable seniors. Packages/groceries were delivered on Christmas Eve morning.
