Early Voting will run through Friday, Nov. 3 and voters can cast their ballot at any of the 29 polling locations located throughout Hidalgo County. Election Day is on Tuesday, Nov. 7, and because Hidalgo County participates in the Countywide Polling Place Program, their ballot will also be at all 40 polling locations.


