Throughout First Quarter:

- School closings are aired, when needed, 4 times an hour between 6:00 am and 8:00 am.
- Interviewed representatives from Clarity (pregnancy and sexually transmitted disease care center) weekly about their services to the community and fundraising Banquets
- Interviewed various pastors and church representatives from around the listening area regarding special services and events during morning and afternoon drive
- Interviewed various representatives from local nonprofits about fundraising events and community services during morning and afternoon drive
- Interviewed Mary Clare Speckner from the Bartholomew County Public Library about community events twice a month
- Promoted Canstruction, a fundraiser for local food banks organized by Bartholomew County United Way, multiple times – Station Manager Keith Maddox served as a judge
- COVID testing, vaccine, and other information from the Bartholomew County Health Department
- Promoted radio show and podcast specifically for women, The Chat with Nita Evans, originating from our sister station WYGS
- Promoted food pantry, homeless shelter, and other services and events of Love Chapel
