

REVISED PARAMETERS FOR OPERATION UNDER POST-SUNSET AUTHORITY (PSSA)

(Post this letter with your current authorization)

THIS AUTHORIZATION SUPERSEDES ANY PREVIOUS POST-SUNSET AUTHORITY

On December 10, 1984, Post-Sunset operation as set forth below can begin.

These values may not be exceeded, but operation at lower power is permitted.

TECHNICAL MATTERS

DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED IN AUTHORIZATION

NOMINAL POWER: The approximate power that the station can use. It is listed only to provide general reference.

ACTUAL POWER: The actual power used by the station.

ANTENNA INPUT POWER: Same as actual power.

CONVERSION FACTOR: The number used to calculate the actual power to be used. See CALCULATION METHOD listed below.

CALCULATION METHOD: To determine the antenna current (or common point current) for post-sunset operation, multiply the antenna current (or common point current) on the station's license by the Conversion Factor on the Post-Sunset Authorization.

EXPLANATION OF OPERATING PERIODS LISTED IN AUTHORIZATION

The post-sunset period begins at local sunset and continues until two hours after local sunset.

Some stations have post-sunset authorizations that allow operation during the entire two hour post-sunset period. Other stations have authorizations specifying operation for only part of this period.

The periods of post-sunset operation and the powers to be used have been calculated for each station, and the times of operation for each month appear on its authorization. No post-sunset operation beyond the times or powers on the PSSA is permitted.

Post-Sunset operating times and powers can vary from month-to-month and take into account the change from standard time to advanced time or vice versa. For some stations, it may not be possible to operate at all in certain months of the year.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Pending completion of negotiations with Mexico, NO STATION MAY CONDUCT POST-SUNSET OPERATION BEYOND 6:00 PM LOCAL TIME. However, the station may continue to operate beyond 6:00 PM local time whenever permitted by its regular license.

LEGAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERSNATURE OF AUTHORITY GRANTED

The Post-Sunset Authority (PSSA) is secondary to the basic license or permit under which the station operates. The PSSA should be posted with the station license or permit. The PSSA may be suspended, modified, or withdrawn by the FCC without prior notice or right to hearing, if necessary to resolve interference conflicts, to implement agreements with foreign governments, or in other circumstances warranting such action. Moreover, the PSSA does not extend beyond the terms of the basic station authorization.

STATUS OF PREVIOUS POST-SUNSET AUTHORITY

The new Post-Sunset Authority you have received supersedes any previous Post-Sunset Authority.

If the new parameters are lower than those previously authorized, the power must be reduced within 30 days of receipt of the new authorization or post-sunset operation must be terminated. Post-Sunset operation may start again when the power reduction is completed.

If the new parameters are higher than those previously authorized, the power may be increased to that level. If you prefer, the station may operate at its old power level or at any other level that does not exceed the new power.

PERIOD OF POST-SUNSET OPERATION

Pending completion of negotiations with Mexico, NO STATION MAY CONDUCT POST-SUNSET OPERATION BEYOND 6:00 PM LOCAL TIME. However, the station may continue to operate beyond 6:00 PM local time whenever permitted by its regular license.

NOTIFICATION PROCEDURE

Before beginning PSSA operation for the first time, a letter should be submitted identifying the station, its call sign and location as well as the method to be used to achieve any needed power reduction.
