



There follows a listing of some of the significant issues responded to by stations WLKM-FM and WRCI-AM, in Three Rivers, Michigan. The listing is by no means exhaustive. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any priority or significance.

01/08/24 - 7a, 8a, 9a, noon, 4 p, 5p – The Branch-Hillsdale-St. Joseph Community Health Agency is offering radon-testing kits at no charge to residents of the tri-county area. Radon is an odorless, tasteless, radioactive gas that occurs naturally in soil and rock. Radon testing recommended every two to five years. A radon testing kit is available at local CHA offices.

01/15/24 - 7a, 8a, 9a, noon, 4 p, 5p – Bronson municipal officials have issued a “run-water” advisory for its customers, according to city manager Brandon Mersman. A run-water advisory means running a small stream of water continually from a faucet. The stream should be about the size of a pencil. Billing adjustments may be made on a case-by-case basis, based on past usage.

02/22/24 - 7a, 8a, 9a, noon, 4p, 5p, - Branch-Hillsdale-St. Joseph Community Health Agency has released its latest video promoting a behind-the-scenes look at the tri-county agency. The resolution authorizes operation of a golf cart on village streets. However, a cart pass must be acquired from the village office. The pass is issued free of charge after proof of insurance and a driver’s license are provided.
