Our TV does not provide the ability to set captions translucently so that solution is unavailable to us at this time, so I will make sure to look for that in my future purchases.

I also understand that wherever the captions are placed will cause blocking of something; I suppose that this is inevitable.

I applaud ABC as a leader in captioning for the deaf; I understand that they were the first network to caption a majority of its programming years ago.
