Section I. Issues

The station has identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- A. HOUSING AVAILABILITY - The lack of available housing in our area for low and median income
- B. BIOP - Environmental land use regulations and the effect on our community

Section II. Responsive Programs

The station has broadcast programming dealing with each of the above-referenced issues. Programming dealing with each issue is set out below.

A. HOUSING AVAILABILITY

“ISSUES AND ANSWERS” - Broadcast on 11/13/16, 11/20/16, 11/27/16, 12/11/16 & 12/25/16; Duration 3.5 minutes. A discussion with Erin Skaar of the Tillamook county housing task force about the lack of available housing in our county. Not just low income housing but the lack of median income housing which would attract qualified workers to businesses in the community.

B. BIOP

“ISSUES AND ANSWERS” - Broadcast on 11/6/16, 12/4/16 & 12/18/16; Duration 3.5 minutes. Commissioner David Yamamoto explains the NOAA Fisheries’ biological opinion in consultation with FEMA flood insurance program. There is a lawsuit proposed by environmental groups that says that the flood insurance program isn’t doing enough to protect endangered salmon and river habitat. The rules and regulations within this biological opinion would devastate Tillamook county and the effects felt in our county would be worse than anywhere else in Oregon.
