**DESCRIPTION: Pennsylvania College of Technology is the recipient of a nearly \$1.5 million dollars grant to support students majoring in a transportation-related field.**

The National Science Foundation awarded \$1,498,465 as part of its S-STEM program, which funds scholarships for academically talented low-income students.

Dubbed the Transportation Scholars, the program will provide up to \$10,000 annually for eligible students, who meet the criteria of high achieving and low income students who have a high school GPA of at least 3.0 and be eligible for pall grant. Recipients are required to seek an associate degree in aviation, automotive, collision repair or diesel.
