Jan 28 – The New Hampshire primaries take place. Ron DeSantis ends his campaign shortly beforehand. Joe Biden defeats Dean Phillips and Marianne Williamson. Donald Trump defeats Nikki Haley. Joe Biden celebrates investments in the Blatnik Bridge, joining leaders from Wisconsin and Minnesota to discuss the project in the Duluth-Superior area. Jen Schultz announces an 8th District campaign, a rematch against Pete Stauber. Murder charges are filed against Minnesota State Trooper Brian Londregan. Rep. Angie Craig is featured in a 1-on-1 interview and Brian McDaniel and Jason Isaacson are featured as political analysts.

Feb 4 – KSTP-SurveyUSA poll results for the presidential race are presented. Kari Dziedzic decides to step down as Senate Majority Leader following a cancer diagnosis. She will not step down from her Senate position. 8th District Congressman Pete Stauber announces he will run for reelection. Republican Joe Fraser decides to run against Democrat Amy Klobuchar for a seat in the U.S. Senate and is featured in a 1-on-1 interview. Kelly Morrison is also featured in a 1-on-1 interview to discuss Dziedic stepping down, and her campaign for the 3rd District of the U.S. House. Brian McClung and Ember Reichgott Junge are featured as political analysts.

Feb 11 – Preview of the 2024 MN legislative session and how the DFL plans to build momentum in their 2nd session with full control of the House, Senate and Governor's Office. Discussion of various legislation including a bill to make MN a sanctuary state for immigrants and a bill to clarify policies related to school resource officers. Mar 3 – Preview of Super Tuesday as presidential candidates begin to campaign in Minnesota. Nikki Haley's visit to MN is highlighted. Mitch McConnell announces a decision to step down as majority leader of the U.S. Senate. The MN Legislature projects a \$3.7 billion surplus, and debate ensues over how it should be spent. Pro-Palestine protestors breach the fence of the St. Paul governor's residence. St. Paul teachers threaten to strike. The Metro Transit Blue Line extension is anticipated to rise in cost and become the most expensive project in Minnesota's history. Mike Erlandson and Annette Meeks are featured as political analysts.

Mar 10 – Super Tuesday primary results are discussed. The Supreme Court rules Donald Trump must remain on state ballots preceding the vote. Joe Biden delivers his State of the Union address. Debate over the Minnesota State Flag continues with the MN GOP supporting efforts to change it. Discussion of KSTP-SurveyUSA poll results regarding support for sports betting legalization and amending Minnesota's constitution to support abortion rights. Brian McClung and Jeff Hayden are featured as political analysts.

Mar 17 – As committee deadlines for the MN Legislature approach, Gov. Tim Walz signs a bill into law to modify the definition of school resource officer. Major changes are made to a bill that would legalize sports betting in Minnesota. An ordinance to increase pay for rideshare drivers is passed in Minnesota, and Uber and Lyft threaten to leave the state by a May deadline. V.P. Kamala Harris visits Minnesota. Rep. Ilhan Omar is featured in a 1-on-1 interview. Brian McDaniel and Ember Reichgott Junge are featured as political analysts.

Mar 24 – Debate over a bill concerning the straw purchasing of guns, which has gained significance due to the killing of 3 Burnsville first responders. MN GOP introduced pro-police bills. The MN Legislature approves millions in tax credits for MN filmmakers. Gov. Tim Walz is featured in a 1-on-1 interview and asked his opinion regarding the prosecution of Minnesota State Trooper Ryan Londregan. Mike Erlandson and Annette Meeks are featured as political analysts.

Mar 31 – The State of the State address by Gov. Tim Walz is highlighted. The governor remains at odds with state lawmakers over funding for EMS in Minnesota. The MN legislature considers ways to refine laws surrounding cannabis and how it can be grown or used. The MN Senate settles a lawsuit with a former employee who claimed she was fired due to her marital status and the views of her husband. 8th district candidate Jen Schultz is featured in a 1-on-1 interview. Three Shots in the Dark

In May 2022, Anna Moriah Wilson, a promising young cyclist bringing new energy to the emerging sport of gravel racing, was suddenly gunned down in Austin, Texas, just days before a major race. The last person to see her alive was fellow cyclist Colin Strickland, who had a brief romantic relationship with Wilson before turning platonic again. Authorities quickly identified a suspect: Colin's on-again/off-again girlfriend, Kaitlin Armstrong. ABC News chief national correspondent Matt Gutman investigates the details of the grisly murder, the 43-day hunt for Kaitlin that crossed state and international lines, and the trial that reached a verdict in November of 2023. The two-hour episode includes exclusive interviews with Mike Armstrong, Kaitlin's father; Nicole Mertz, Kaitlin's former friend who tipped off police to disturbing comments she allegedly made about Moriah; and a neighbor at the crime scene who provided key surveillance videos to authorities. The episode also features the first interviews with Jose Garza, Travis County district attorney, and prosecutors Rickey Jones and Guillermo Gonzalez. Additional interviews include Kaitlin's neighbors in Costa Rica, including one who witnessed her arrest.

Missing from the Mall

On a November afternoon in 2003, Dru Sjodin, a senior at the University of North Dakota, was finishing some Christmas shopping when she vanished from the parking lot of her local mall. When authorities arrived at the scene, they discovered a chilling piece of evidence — the sheath of a handheld knife. In a new "20/20," "Nightline" co-anchor Juju Chang reports on Dru's disappearance, the investigation that led police to Alfonso Rodriguez — a local man with a violent history – and the trial that ended in North Dakota's first death sentence in over 100 years that was later overturned. The two-hour program includes an impassioned interview with Allan Sjodin, Dru's father, who hasn't spoken on national TV since Alfonso Rodriguez's death sentence was overturned.

Twenty years later, a different detective took a fresh look at the evidence and was able to find a match for the fingerprints: Scott Hatley, a local man with a violent history. However, the details of the gruesome murder and Scott's motives remained a mystery until 2022, when Scott's writings about his life and crimes found in a trailer next to his dead body shed new light on the case. In a new "20/20," ABC News contributor Chris Connelly takes viewers inside the shocking murder and the decadeslong search for answers.

Quincy, Illinois, couple Tim and Becky Bliefnick are busy. They both work, and Becky is also in nursing school, all while raising two young children with one on the way. Tim jokes on national television that he regrets his marriage, and a couple of months later, one of the Bliefnicks is dead. This case drew national attention and evidence included authorities discovering a grainy surveillance video of a ghostly figure on a bike. Could that phantom be the killer?

For over a decade, Gypsy-Rose Blanchard lived in a wheelchair and allegedly suffered from multiple medical issues, including leukemia, seizures and muscular dystrophy. Known in her community as a local hero, Gypsy and her mother, Dee Dee, spoke at conferences, met celebrities, and even received a home from Habitat for Humanity. However, everything changed in 2015, when police discovered Dee Dee stabbed to death in her home and named Gypsy and her secret boyfriend, Nicholas Godejohn, as the main suspects. In a case that reverberated across the nation, experts revealed that this was likely a case of Munchausen by proxy, a form of abuse, usually by a parent to their child, in which a guardian exaggerates or induces illness in a child often motivated by a desire for attention and sympathy — Gypsy says she was a healthy young woman. In a new "20/20," co-anchor Deborah Roberts sits down with Gypsy one week after her release from prison to talk about life behind bars, her reckoning with her past, and how she is dealing with her newfound fame.

The program features interviews with Emily Palmer, senior crime writer at People Magazine; Randy Kester, attorney for Kevin Franke; Adam Steed, Stephanie Jones and Trey Warner, former therapy patients of Jodi Hildebrandt; and Jo Piazza, author and host of the "Under the Influence" podcast.

"20/20" reports on well-known West Coast lawyer Larry McNabney who disappeared after a horse show. His fifth wife, Elisa McNabney, claimed he broke up with her and left town. The investigation uncovered a twisted web of lies in Elisa's wake, including how Elisa's real name was Laren Sims and that she played a shocking role in McNabney's death.
