PROGRAMS THAT SERVE THE NEEDS AND INTERESTS OF THE COMMUNITY BROADCAST ON WDEF-TV 12.1 AND 12.2

CBS SUNDAY MORNING – airs Sunday mornings 9:00-10:30 am. A weekly program that combines the latest spot news and weather and a variety of others including health, travel and the arts. A good variety of topics that range from coast to coast locally, nationally and internationally.

FACE THE NATION – airs Sunday mornings 10:30 – 11:00am and Sunday night 12:05 – 12:35am. This weekly program covers the hot topics in the news. It features a weekly moderator with guest interviewer and panelists to discuss various current news topics.

POINT OF VIEW – airs Saturdays 3:30-4am and 6:30-7am on 12.1. Effective Sunday, February 3, 2013, Point of View also began airing at 9:30-10am on 12.2. WDEF-TV produces this locally-produced weekly program. It covers various topics such as local politics, ethics, inner city violence, and education, the arts, and health issues, to name a few. It is a fine example of programming that reflects the current concerns, needs and interest of the community.

60 MINUTES – airs Sunday 7:00 – 8:00pm. This program usually features three separate segments on different subjects from investigative reports to interviews with presidents, congressional representatives, and everyday citizens.

48 HOURS INVESTIGATES – airs on Saturdays 10:00 – 11:00pm (moves to other times/days on occasion). A weekly program, it usually covers one subject in depth. The subject matter varies from violence, to missing children, to the AIDS epidemic, to the airline crashes. It is reflective of what is currently on the minds of Americans.

NEWS 12 THIS MORNING – airs from 5:00 – 7:00am Monday through Friday on WDEF 12.1 plus two hours of broadcast airs 6:00 – 8:00am on 12.2. It is hosted by two co-anchors and a meteorologist and encompasses news, weather, and community affairs. It contains live interviews and taped segments. It covers a variety of subjects ranging from health and consumer related issues to cultural and social events. The program also gives viewers an opportunity to call in live on the air and ask medical, legal and other consumer questions of qualified professionals in various fields.

NEWS 12 AT 12:00 noon, 6:00pm, 7:00pm and 11:00pm airs on 12.1 – The news programs air Monday through Friday. Weekend editions air Saturday and Sunday at 11:00pm. The

programs consist of news, weather and taped segments, mostly local news with some national news packages from CBS.

WHAT'S RIGHT WITH OUR SCHOOLS – A segment in our newscasts on Mondays which features positive elements within our schools. It varies from people, places to things which help to improve the educational process for our children.

GOLDEN APPLE – Every other Tuesday, during our 6:00pm newscast, an area teacher is saluted as being instrumental in a child's life. The dedication and efforts by the teacher have helped motivate and direct many young people in the right direction. The teachers are nominated by parents-students and co-workers.

KIDCASTER – Parents are encouraged to nominate their child who might have an ambition of being a weathercaster and is between the age of 8 and 12 years old. We ask them to talk with their child then write in to the station telling why they would like to be a weather kidcaster. Each week a young person is selected from the applicants to come to the station, watch a live newscast up close in the studio then tape a weather segment with meteorologist, Patrick Core. The kidcaster segment then airs during our 11:00pm newscast on Mondays and on *News 12 This Morning* on Tuesday mornings.

On October 1, 2012, WDEF began broadcasting Bounce TV on its second digital channel on 12.2.
