Local issues addressed during the quarter

The below are local issues of concern to the community. Programs on the station that addressed these issues are listed on the following pages.

Local Issue/Concern	Brief description of local issue/concern
Agriculture	Crop damage, food insecurity, and suspicious seed packages
Community/Volunteerism	Businesses and individuals gave time, money, and products to make sure the community had food, masks, and opportunities to support each other. This was especially important this quarter because of the wide impacts of The Derecho and COVID-19.
Crime	Personal safety is often a matter of concern, especially regarding the safety of youth.
Elderly	Concerns surrounded COVID-19 and the safety of individuals in senior living facilities. Efforts of groups focused on technology to help bridge the distance for relationships with family.
Government	Issues of concern for Central Iowans included financial relief, mask guidelines and other health and finance regulations due to COVID-19.
Medical	Medical concerns centered on COVID-19. People wanted to know how to prevent and get tested for the disease, as well as how to stay fit mentally when forced into socially distanced lifestyles.
Minority	Civil Rights is at the forefront of discussion for many lowans. Voting rights changes, celebrating Black history and efforts for social change continue to be of concern.
Youth	Whether kids would be schooling at home or in the classroom, and the dangers that either of those could impose during a Pandemic is the overwhelming area of concern regarding youth.
