1. The Oklahoma Blood Institute (OBI) conducts blood drives throughout the listening area. Lakes Country Radio provide a page within our website exclusively for the OBI. In addition, we broadcast all of the blood drive within and just outside the listening area in order to assist the OBI with donations. All blood donated stays within our area to help those in need. KEOK / KTLQ have received the partnership award for the past 2 years, and are planning to continue that support.
2. Angels Care Home Health & Go Ye Village, a retirement center conduct regular monthly meeting which empowers patients and caregivers with realistic knowledge and a greater acceptance of the diseases of Alzheimer's and Dementia. We provide coverage with on air interviews and website presence on our bulletin board page.

3. Help In Crisis serves and protects women and children that are victims of domestic violence. Each year Help In Crisis holds a Bass Tournament to raise funds to assist these families. We are proud to help in this cause. We also support the "Walk A Mile In Her Shoes Event each year, and run and audio PSA on air to bring awareness to these needs.

4. CASA or Court Appointed Special Advocate of Cherokee County holds an annual local volunteer program that recruits and trains volunteers to serve as advocates for abused and neglected children in juvenile deprived proceedings. Lakes Country Radio supports CASA through on air interviews, website presence and promotion of their annual event.

5. Lakes Country Radio has and will continue to support local individuals and families in time of need. Some are injured in a vehicle crash, some lose their home to fire, and some suffer from cancer. Events are created to gain support from the community to assist them. We place flyers on the bulletin board on our website, and broadcast event times and locations as well as who the benefit is for.
