

Programming: The new jail would sit on 15 acres of land off 29N across from Chatham Middle School. The new facility is expected to be 98,000 sq. ft and have 146 beds with the ability to expand to 202 beds. The total cost is expected to be just under \$63 million. According to the Chairman of the Pittsylvania Co. Board of Supervisors, Darrell Dalton, the request to the state would cover about 25% of the cost. The State Department of Corrections will render their decision sometime in 2025. (Newscasts)
