4	Establishment of an intern program designed to assist members of the community	WATE-TV partners with area colleges and universities in a program designed to give students applicable career experience. Participation for the period covered in this report was 16 students. These students worked in the departments of News, Sports, Production, Creative Service, or Community Relations depending upon the student's specific area of study. These interns represented the following schools: University of Tennessee, North Greenville University, Virginia Tech, Arizona State University, and Johnson University.
5	Establishment of a mentoring program	There are individuals in every department who have Individual Development Plans that they are working through with their Department Head. The IDPs help both the individual and their manager in looking for opportunities to develop the individual's skills so that he or she will be more qualified for advancement. This may include attending management training workshops, or strategic planning or budgeting meetings at the station, for example. The station aims to have potential successors in line when a manager leaves.
6	Participation in Job Fairs	WATE-TV personnel including Operations Manager, Executive Producer, Creative Services Director, Director of Programming & Community Development attended the University of Tennessee College of Communication & Information Job and Internship Fair on 10/19/16. Approximately 200 college students attended the event. Students were advised about internship opportunities and job/internship applications were accepted from students.
