<u>DSF Gala</u> - General Colin Powell spoke at this year's event for the Denver Scholarship Foundation fundraising dinner, the Ed Gala. Since 2007, the DSF has awarded \$17 million in college and technical school scholarships to 3,300 graduates of the Denver Public Schools.
