• Oct. 16, 2023

The Nebraska Department of Agriculture received a report of a horse in the Panhandle that has contracted West Nile virus (WNV). Horses can become infected with WNV after being bitten by an infected mosquito; however, they cannot transmit WNV to other horses or people after they contract the disease. While many horses can be exposed to the disease and not show symptoms, about 35% will become ill and will have to be potentially euthanized July 14, 2024.

Oct 19, 2023

The University of Nebraska-Lincoln's Center for Agricultural Profitability and Nebraska Extension will host a series of price risk management workshops for cattle producers in Franklin, Trenton, Rushville, and Bridgeport in December. Attendees will learn strategies designed to reduce risk exposure to achieve a profitable outcome in uncertain times.

Oct. 26 2023

Alliance, NE – Due to forecasted cold temperatures, the Alliance Parks Department has winterized public bathrooms at Laing Lake and Central Park. These restrooms will not be available during the winter season.

Oct. 26 2023

Many in the Rushville community are concerned after information revealed the potential of the town losing their primary grocery store, Rushville Super Foods, formerly known as Ideal Market.

The Rushville Chamber of Commerce issued a statement on Thursday saying that they received word that Rushville Super Foods, the only grocery store in town is closing soon.

There is a community meeting set on Friday morning at 8:30 A.M at the Security First Center Theater to discuss the situation.

Nov. 3. 2023

There was a hostage situation that lasted over 6 hours in Alliance on Nov. 2. The situation ended peacefully late on Nov 2. When Yadira Garza turned herself in to authorites after a standoff with police and holding her child hostage.

Garza of Alliance was charged Tuesday with Use of a Firearm to Commit a Felony, a Class 1C Felony, Terroristic threats, a Class 1C felony, and Obstruction of Government Operations, a Class 1 misdemeanor.

Nov. 14, 2023

Nebraska Game and Parks will decommission and remove the dam at Carter P. Johnson Lake at Fort Robinson State Park for the safety of the public. Once the dam is removed, Soldier Creek will be restored to a natural flowing state.

The 480-foot-long earthen dam, built in 1935, was reclassified as a high-hazard-potential dam in February 2020 by the Nebraska Department of Natural Resources. It has since been found to be deficient in three areas that could lead to its sudden or complete failure.

Nov. 22, 2023

Alliance, NE –The Interim BID Board appointed in August continues to discuss snow removal in partnership with the City of Alliance. The City crews will make their best effort to remove snow downtown during non-business hours.

Once customers arrive, it's harder for the city crews to safely remove snow. The finer details are still being worked out, including how everything will be communicated.
