On April 12, 2005, WVUA-CA, WDVZ-CA, and WJMY-CA were granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until April 1, 2013. WUOA was granted a license on March 31, 2005.

Our licenses will expire on April 1, 2013. We must file applications for renewal with the FCC December 1, 2012. When filed, a copy of the applications will be available for public inspection at [www.fcc.gov](http://www.fcc.gov). It contains information concerning the stations' performance during the last eight years.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal applications and to whether the stations have operated in the public interest should file comments and petitions with the FCC by March 1, 2013.
