


The attached document was timely prepared by the January 10, 2019, deadline.

As a result of the federal government shutdown that started on December 22, 2018, the FCC's online public file (OPIF) system was inaccessible and non-functioning from January 3, 2019, until January 27, 2019.

Consequently, the attached document was not uploaded until after the January 10 quarterly filing deadline, after the federal government reopened and the FCC's OPIF system was put back into service.

Quarterly Certification of Continuing "Class A Television" Eligibility

Class A television station KPSP-CD, Indio-Palm Springs, CA, licensed to Gulf-California Broadcast Company, hereby certifies that, during the prior **4th Quarter 2018**, it has (1) broadcast a minimum of 18 hours per day, (2) broadcast an "average" of at least three (3) hours per week of locally-produced programming and (3) generally complied with the same FCC rules that are applicable to full-power TV stations (except for differences due to the unique nature of the Class A television service).
