Statement of EEO Policy

For purposes of this Report, a vacancy was deemed "filled" not when the offer was extended, but when the hiree accepted the job offer and passed a background check and drug test. A person was deemed "interviewed" whether he or she was interviewed in person, over the phone or via email.
