At the same time, Russia's ally, China, has also threatened war with the United States. The communist regime in Beijing has undertaken a massive military and nuclear weapons build up and is vowing to conquer Taiwan by any means necessary. China's growing alliance with Russia poses a major problem for America. Its alliance with North Korea poses yet another. Kim Jonq-un's forces have already test fired dozens of ballistic missiles this year and are working on intercontinental missiles; ICBMs that could one day reach the United States. Meanwhile in the Middle East, the hour is late to stop Iran's nuclear program. At this point, perhaps, only Israel will prevent Iran's Ayatollahs from acquiring the world's deadliest weapons. Russia, China, North Korea, and Iran. Four governments with serious ideological differences that are nonetheless united by their hostility toward the U.S. and their desire to see America toppled as the world's superpower. How should we respond to these unprecedented challenges? These wars and rumors of wars. Is our leadership up to the task? And how can Christians be a voice of truth and shine a light in the growing darkness? Over the next hour, you'll hear from Colonel Oliver North, Senator Joni Ernst, Colonel Allen West, Pastor Jack Hibbs, and others as we break down the gathering storm against America; addressing economic, environmental, public safety, substance abuse, youth, and spiritual issues facing our nation.
