Rene Martinez was the former Leader of ruthless Miami gang, Latin Syndicate. Rene didn't have a father-figure growing up and was raised by his mother who was into drugs as well as a dark religion called Santeria. As a child his mother sacrificed chickens and goats and poured the blood of the sacrificed animals on him and other children in the family. When they finally poured the blood onto Rene, he stated that a spiritual door was immediately opened to him, and he began to see demons. Dealing with this sort of childhood led Rene to seek another family in the streets at the early age of nine. They would steal cars, break into houses, and spray paint walls. At the age of sixteen, Rene was charged with attempted murder, went into a facility, and was later released. It was at the age of seventeen, that Rene became the leader of the gang, Latin Syndicate. As the leader, Rene found himself fighting all the time, dodging bullets, and attending many funerals. It wasn't until his friend invited him to church that he had his first encounter with God, however three days later he was back on the streets because he did not know how to let go of the street image he lived with and was used to. After that he began bare-knuckle fighting, becoming an MMA fighter, and owned a gangster rap music label. Lost in the world of sin, Rene felt the demon of death calling him and he began to think about hell. It was at this point that Rene heard God say that He would remove His hedge of protection over his life if Rene didn't change his ways and submit to Christ. Rene was baptized and began his ministry, Jesus Christ Street Ministry, preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ in prisons and building projects across the country.

Meanwhile in the Middle East, the hour is late to stop Iran's nuclear program. At this point, perhaps, only Israel will prevent Iran's Ayatollahs from acquiring the world's deadliest weapons. Russia, China, North Korea, and Iran. Four governments with serious ideological differences that are nonetheless united by their hostility toward the U.S. and their desire to see America toppled as the world's superpower. How should we respond to these unprecedented challenges? These wars and rumors of wars. Is our leadership up to the task? And how can Christians be a voice of truth and shine a light in the growing darkness? She's seen the tyranny of China's government up close and she's sounding the alarm that it could come here courtesy of the great reset. Amid all the sweeping changes that the World Economic Forum and other proponents of the great reset have put forward, one name is never mentioned God. How should Christians view this great reset and does it seek to place man above the Almighty? During the 1960s, an assault started on Christianity public displays. In 1962, prayer in schools was eliminated. In 1963, bible reading was also removed. In 1980, the Supreme Court said it was unconstitutional to display the 10 commandments in the halls of Kentucky schools (Stone versus Graham). The Supreme Court stated that if copies of the commandments were displayed, it would motivate students to read and obey the commandments, which was not acceptable under the Establishment Clause. Years after this decision was made, during one school day, students were praying before school and a young 14-year-old boy walked into the school and opened fire. Samaritan's Purse also provides a discipleship program for the children called, The Greatest Journey. The Greatest Journey is composed of 12 lessons where they study, test, and memorize scripture. When children complete The Greatest Journey program, they receive a certificate, a bible, and a graduation ceremony with a cap and gown. Around 4.5 million young individuals have graduated and participated in The Greatest Journey program. The hope is that through The Greatest Journey program, children could then share their newly gained biblical understanding to other children and/or their parents, leading them to Christ as well.
