

License Renewal Announcement Reminder for:

New Mexico

TV, Class A LPTV, LPTV and TV Translator Stations

TV, Class A TV, LPTV and TV translator stations licensed to communities in New Mexico must file license renewal applications must be filed by June 1, 2006. Accordingly, pre-filing announcements must start on April 1, 2006.

Pre-filing Announcements

The first of four pre-filing renewal announcements must air on April 1, 2006. The remaining announcements must air on April 16, May 1, and May 16. The text of the announcement is established by the Commission's Rules and is included below. For commercial stations, at least two of the four pre-filing announcements must air between 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. (5:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. Central and Mountain Time). A sign board or slide showing the licensee's address and the Commission's Washington, DC address, which is included in the text below, must be displayed while the pre-filing announcements are being broadcast.

The text of the announcement is as follows:

K481K
On September 28, 1998, KTDO was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until October 1, 2006.

Our license will expire on October 1, 2006. We must file an application for renewal with the FCC by June 1, 2006. When filed, a copy of this application will be available for public inspection during our regular business hours. It contains information concerning this station's performance during the last eight years.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application and to whether this station has operated in the public interest should file comments and petitions with the Commission by September 1, 2006. Further information concerning the FCC's broadcast license renewal process is available at 10033 Carnegie, El Paso, TX 79925 or may be obtained from the FCC, Washington, D.C. 20554

Post-filing Announcements

Once the license renewal application has been filed, television, Class A and locally-originating low power television stations **must broadcast six post-filing renewal announcements.** These announcements must air on **June 1, June 16, July 1, July 16, August 1, and August 16.** At least three of these announcements must air between 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. (**5:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m.** Central and Mountain Time). At least one announcement must air in each of the following time periods: between **9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.**, between **1:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m.**, and between **5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.** Again, a sign board or slide showing the licensee's address and the Commission's Washington, DC address must be displayed while the post-filing announcements are being broadcast.

The text of the announcement is as follows:

On September 28, 1998, ^{K481K}KTDO was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until **October 1, 2006.**

Our license will expire on **October 1, 2006.** We have filed an application for renewal with the FCC.

A copy of this application is available for public inspection during our regular business hours. It contains information concerning this station's performance during the last eight years.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application and to whether this station has operated in the public interest should file comments and petitions with the FCC by September 1, 2006.

Further information concerning the FCC's broadcast license renewal process is available at 10033 Carnegie, El Paso, TX or may be obtained from the FCC, Washington, DC 20554.

Statement of Compliance

Within seven days of the broadcast of the last post-filing announcement, that is, by August 23, 2006, television and Class A television station licensees should complete a **Statement of Compliance** certifying that the announcements were made consistent with the above directions and place it in the station's public inspection file.
